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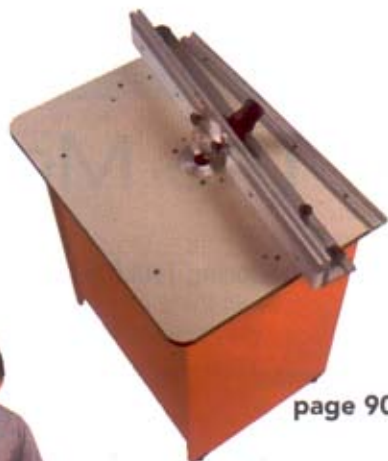
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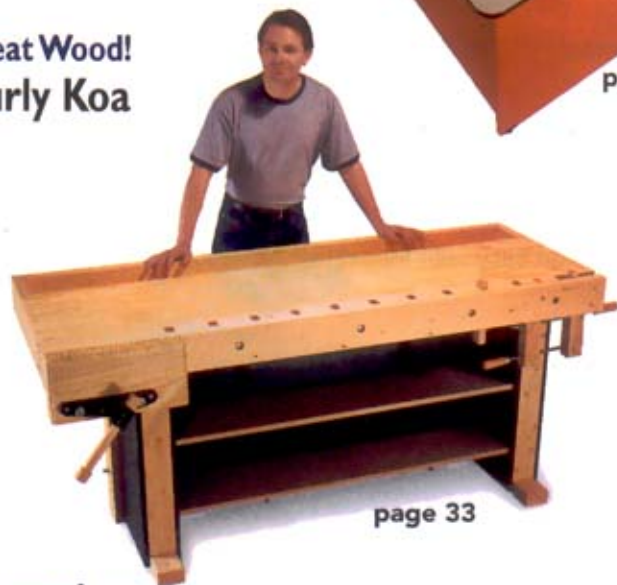
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Question & Answer

Clean Up Squeeze Out

Q. I saw one of those woodworking wizards on television the other day. As I watched the guy build a three-day project in 30 minutes, I noticed he washed off glue squeeze out with a wet cloth immediately after clamping. Won't the water weaken the glue joint?

A. We went right to the folks who manufacture Tite-Bond glue to help us answer your question. Here's what we found out:

Don't try to rub the glue off with a wet rag. This will probably spread the glue around, water it down and sometimes force the diluted glue down into the joint.

It's better to use a damp 3M Scotch-Brite pad or synthetic steel wool. Both pick up the glue without spreading it

around. Keep the pad in a bowl of water while you glue up your boards. Then, hold the pad up by a corner so all the excess water drains out. Wipe the glue with the damp pad using short, rolling strokes. Use a clean part of the pad for each stroke. The rolling motion creates a scraping action that lifts the glue

off the wood rather than rubbing it in. Refresh a glue-soaked pad by rinsing it out in water.

Stick with this method and you'll avoid any problems with forcing watery glue into the joint or the pores of the surrounding wood. And don't believe everything you see on TV!



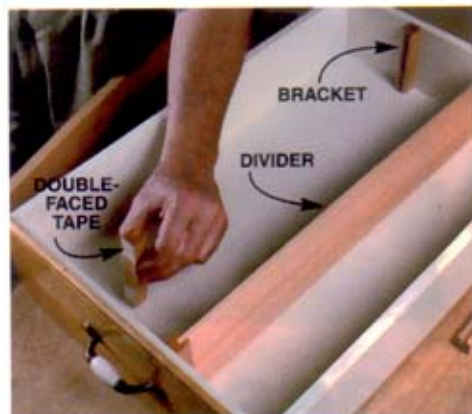
Easy Drawer Dividers

Q. Help! The junk drawer in our kitchen is out of control! I have trouble finding anything in there. Is there a simple way to add dividers to my kitchen drawers without taking them apart?

A. You bet! Here's a way to control the clutter in less time than it takes to find the potato peeler.

To make the brackets that hold the dividers in place, groove the edge of a 3/4-in.-thick board on your router table and round over the outside edges. Then rip the grooved edge off the board and crosscut to length. I like to attach the brackets with double-faced tape or a little hot-melt glue. That way you can reposition them to suit your ever-changing collection of kitchen junk.





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Question & Answer

Getting Stain Out of Corners

Q. I like using gel stain on difficult to stain woods like birch because it doesn't leave a blotchy look. But man, the stuff is a pain to get out of corners. No matter how hard I push, I can't force the rag deep enough into the corner to clean up the excess stain. Got any neat tricks?

A. It's no picnic to get any kind of stain out of a corner, and the thick consistency of gel stain makes it especially tough. Here's our suggestion: Use a dry brush to whisk away the excess gel stain. Unlike a rag, the bristles of the brush are easy to get into corners. Use a rag to wipe excess stain off the brush and to keep it dry. It works great! Be sure to clean the brush after you're done so it's ready to come to the rescue the next time you stain yourself into a corner.



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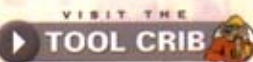
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Better Joints

Q. I like the clean look of thin, solid-wood edge banding on plywood. But, without a jointer to remove the saw marks, I'm unable to get an invisible joint. Any suggestions for a guy without a jointer?

A. Instead of a jointer, you can use a router table. An up-cut spiral bit does the best job, but a straight cutter will do.

For the board to have continuous support before and after the cut, you'll need to create an offset on the outfeed side of the fence that's equal to the amount of wood removed. A strip of self-stick ultra-high molecular weight (UHMW) tape on an auxiliary fence does the trick. UHMW is a special plastic that wears forever and provides a

slick surface for the wood to glide on. Using a straightedge, set the fence so the cutter is exactly flush with the taped side.

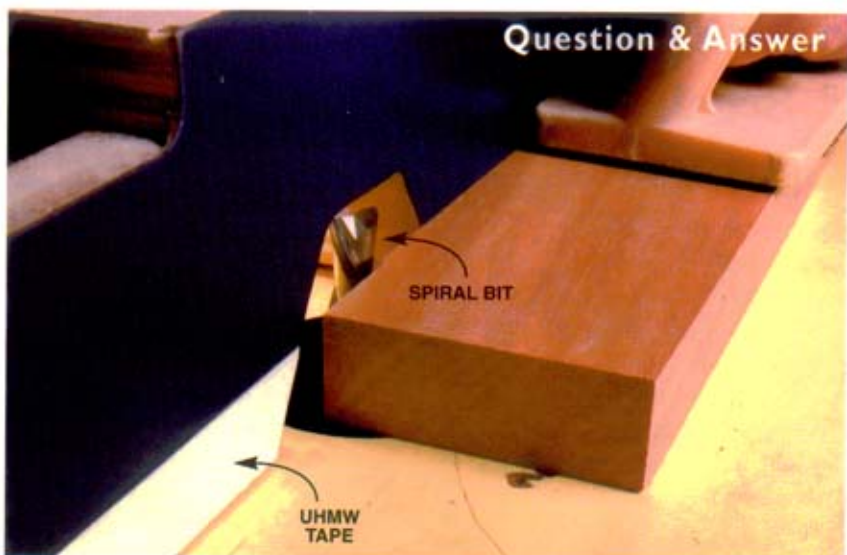
To make the narrow strips for your invisible joint, start with a wide board and clean up one edge on the router table. Then rip the 1/4-in. strip from the clean edge of the board. Repeat for as

many strips as you need.

A Brush for Tight Spots

Q. I built a little TV stand for our living room that included a 4-in. space for the DVD player. It seemed like a great idea until I went to varnish the piece. That's when I realized I couldn't get a brush in that little space. What should I have done?

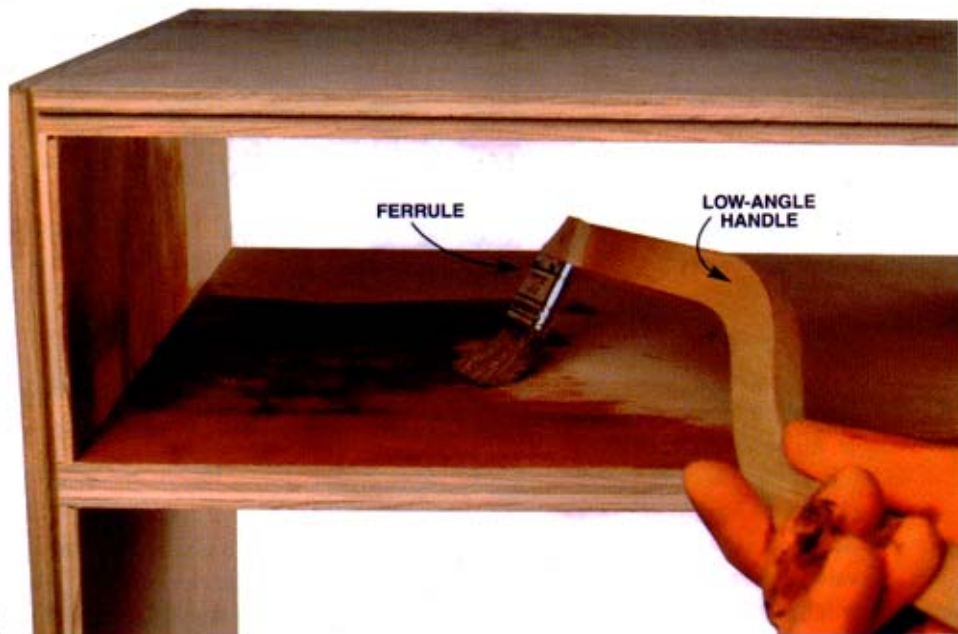

A. Well, this may sound crazy, but when the handle of my brush gets in the way, I get the handle out of the way. That's right—cut the darn thing off!

Pick a brush you don't mind sacri-

ficing, and cut the handle off just above the metal ferrule. Screw on a new handle made from scrap wood at a 90-

degree angle. A slight S-curve on the handle keeps a low profile on the brush so it can easily fit into the tightest space.



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Oops!

One Step at a Time

Q. ARGH! I cut all the parts according to the cutting list and my face-frame came up short! I worked out the math and the cutting list was correct. What went wrong?

A. Rule number one when building complex projects directly from a set of plans: Don't cut every part at once! If you cut and fit as you go, your project is bound to work out. Also, if there is an error in a plan, you'll likely spot it before it's too late.

The problem with completely trusting a cutting list has to do with the fact that one small discrepancy affects the dimensions of subsequent parts. Maybe the fence on your tablesaw was off by a hair and your shelves were a bit long or maybe your 1/4-in.-deep dados were a little shallow. These small differences can add up to a carcass that's too wide for the face frame dimension that's specified in the



plan. The solution is to build complex projects as a series of components and to cut and fit the rest of the project to what's already been built. In your case, cutting and dry fitting the plywood box first, then measuring to see what size the face frame really needed to be would've saved you time, material and aggravation.

Clean Bandsaw Tires

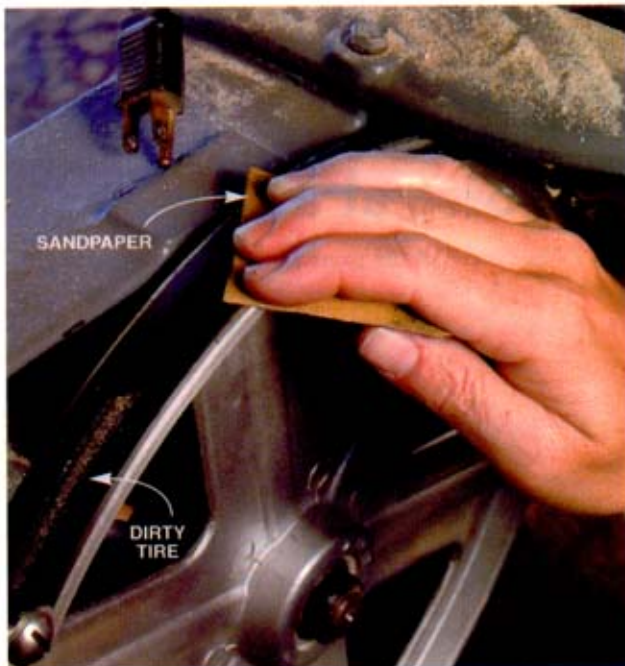
Q. My bandsaw tires have a buildup of pitch and sawdust that seems to be embedded right into the rubber. What's the best way to clean my tires?

A. An excessive buildup of sawdust and pitch on your tires can lead to tracking problems, so it's a good idea to clean them periodically.

Start by unplugging your machine. Then remove the blade and tilt the table out of the way. You'll find the buildup to be much worse on your lower tire where sawdust tends to get trapped under the blade as it travels around the wheel. Use some 120-grit sandpaper or synthetic steel wool and a light touch to clean the wheel as you turn it by hand. **AW**

CLARIFICATION: In the Cutting List on page 59 of our Wooden Storm Door story, AW #88, August 2001, the dimensions for the grid (parts E through K) are ambiguous. The grid is 1-1/16-in. thick. Viewed from the front, as in Detail 1, all the parts are 3/4-in. wide. We regret any inconvenience this may have caused.

Splinter-Free Jigsawing

Last winter I jigsawed a whole bunch of toy parts from a sheet of plywood. I love my jigsaw, but it never fails—that darn plywood splinters every time. Finer saw blades helped, but it took way too long to cut the parts. Plywood is so expensive, I had to find a better way to cut it.

My solution? A zero-clearance base plate made from 1/8-in. hardboard. I cut a V-notch with a slot for the blade and I secured it to the base with double-faced tape. Now my cuts are virtually splinter free!

No-Hassle Filter Cleaning

My air filter works great and sure makes my shop a cleaner and healthier place to work. But cleaning the pleated filter was always a problem. Blowing or shaking it out just made a big mess. I tried vacuuming it, but my vacuum wand would attach itself to the filter like a leech!

I tamed the beast by drilling some 3/4-in. holes in the sides of the wand. Now I just shake the wand around inside the filter and it clears out the dust without clinging to the filter. The number of holes you put in the wand depends on how powerful your vacuum is. Drill just enough holes so the wand doesn't stick to the filter.

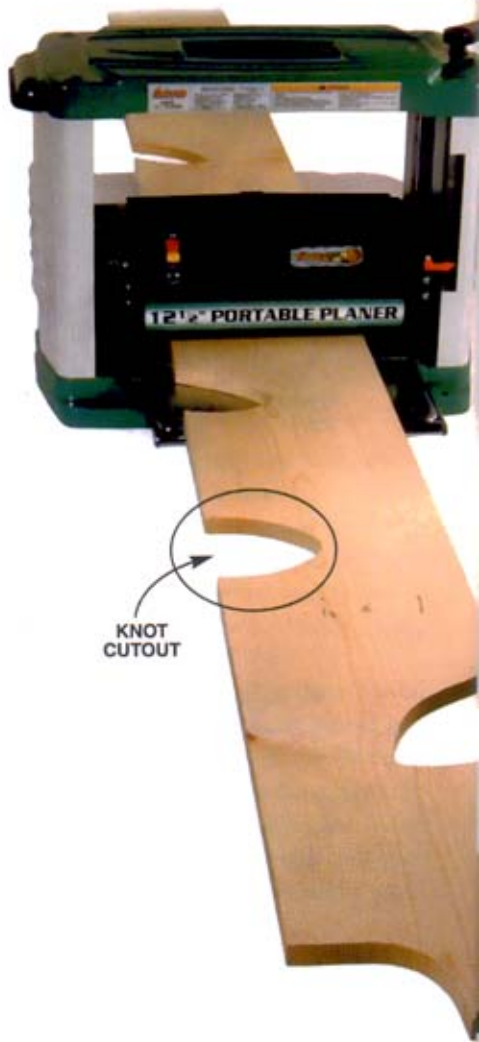

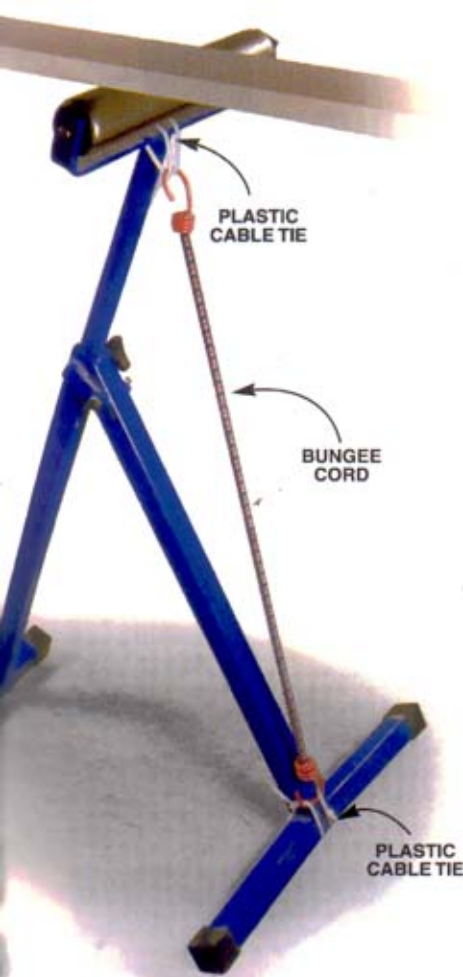
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Knot-Free Planing

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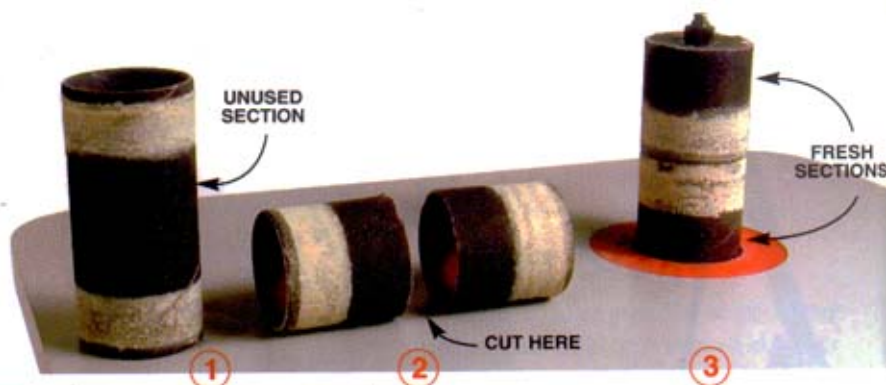

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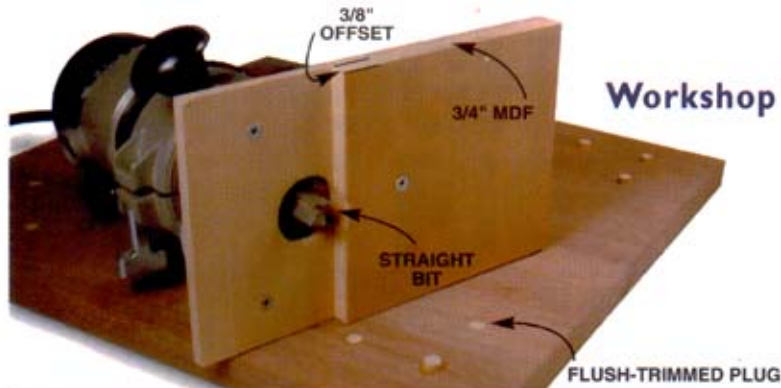

Plug-Trimming Router Base

I attached the new base with long screws and adjusted the router bit so it cuts just shy of the full thickness of the new base. It trims the plugs almost perfectly flush, leaving me just a little scraping or sanding.

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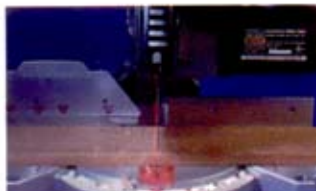
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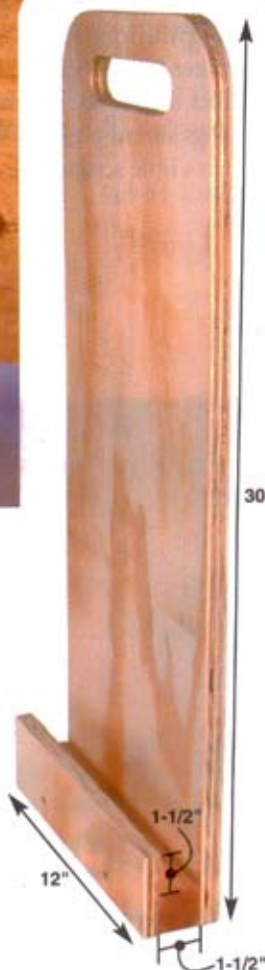

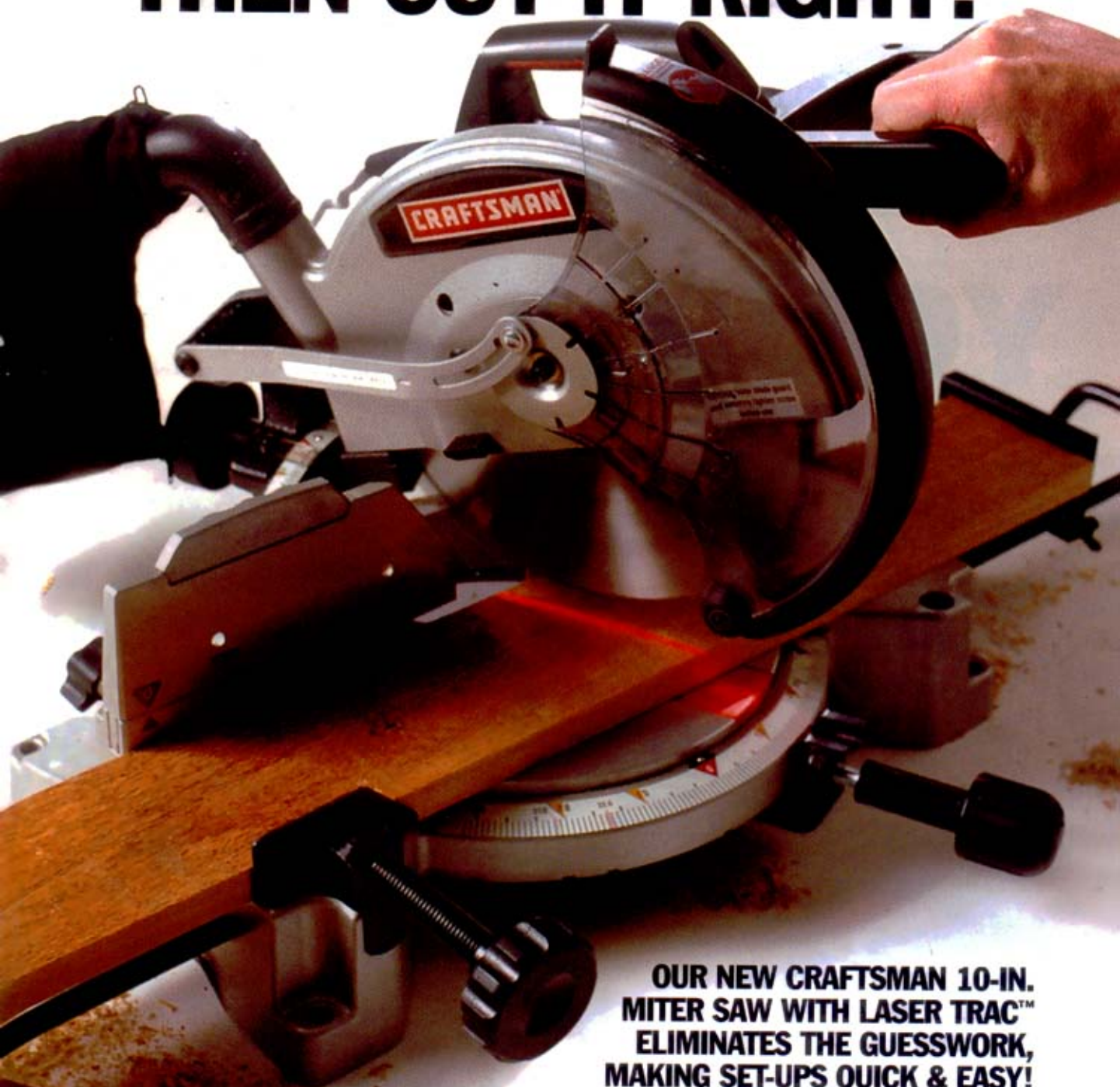
Straight-Shooting Drill Jig

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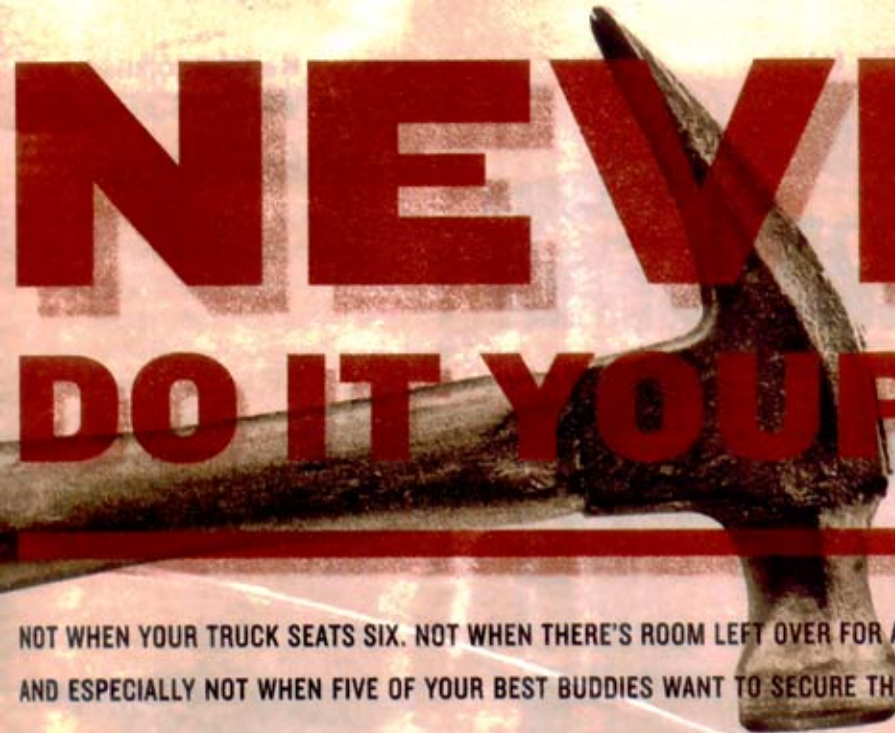
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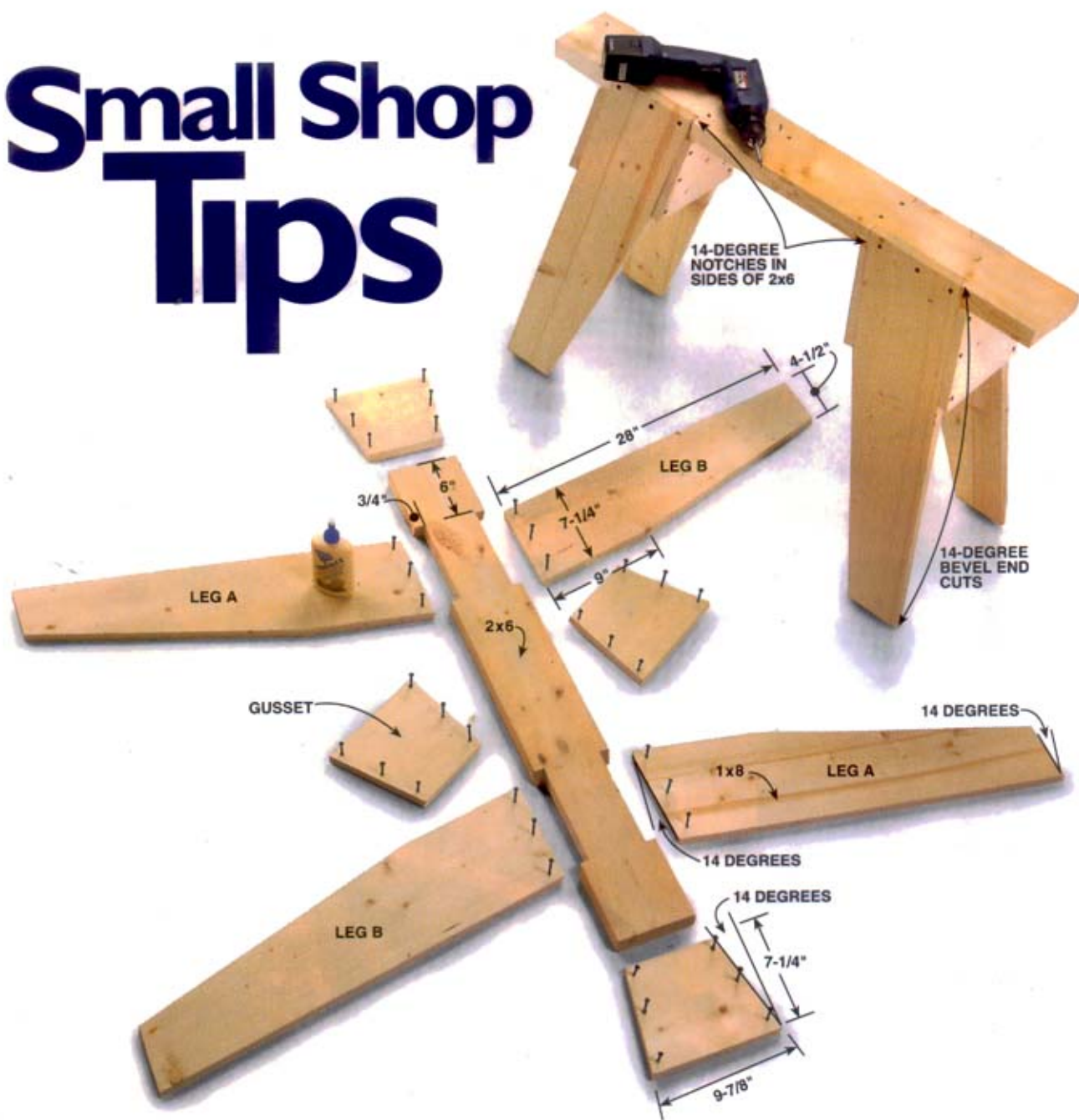

Small Shop Tips

I've found a sturdy sawhorse that's great even if you have limited space. When I'm done working with them I just stack them on top of each other and store them out of the way. Here's all it takes to build one horse:

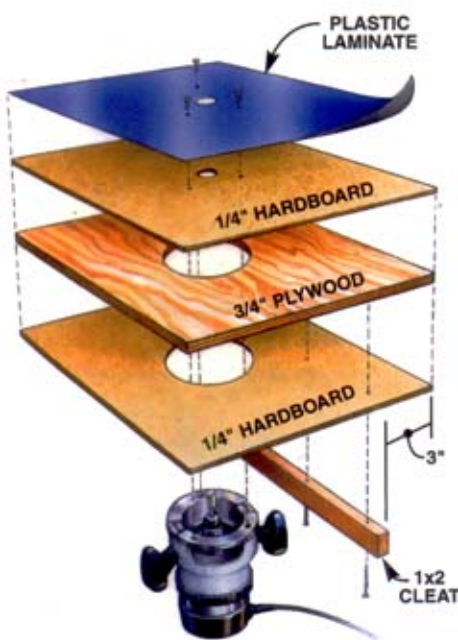
Notch the top board so the legs angle outward and toward the ends. Legs A and B are mirror images of each other and have compound 14-degree angle cuts at both ends. The four gussets are identical.

To assemble, predrill screw holes in the legs and gussets. Loosely screw the legs in the notches and screw and glue the gussets to the edges of the legs. Because the legs are not screwed tight, it's easy to line up the gussets. Tighten the screws that hold the legs to the top board and you're done.

Space-Saving Router Table

I never thought I'd have room for a router table. After a couple years of messing around with different designs I came up with this compact table that sets up and knocks down in seconds and can be stored almost anywhere. You can clamp it to the edge of a workbench or across a pair of sawhorses. It's also easy to make, because instead of routing out the opening, it's simply sawn out.



Glue the bottom piece of 1/4-in. hardboard to the plywood core. Then use your router's base plate to trace the hole for the base. Cut the hole with a jig-saw and glue on the top piece of 1/4-in. hardboard. Add the plastic laminate to complete the "sandwich." Use the router base to locate the screw holes. Drill these holes and countersink them from the top. Add a 1x2 cleat to the bottom of the table about 3 in. from the back edge. The cleat helps brace the table against your bench. Finish off the top with a little paste wax.

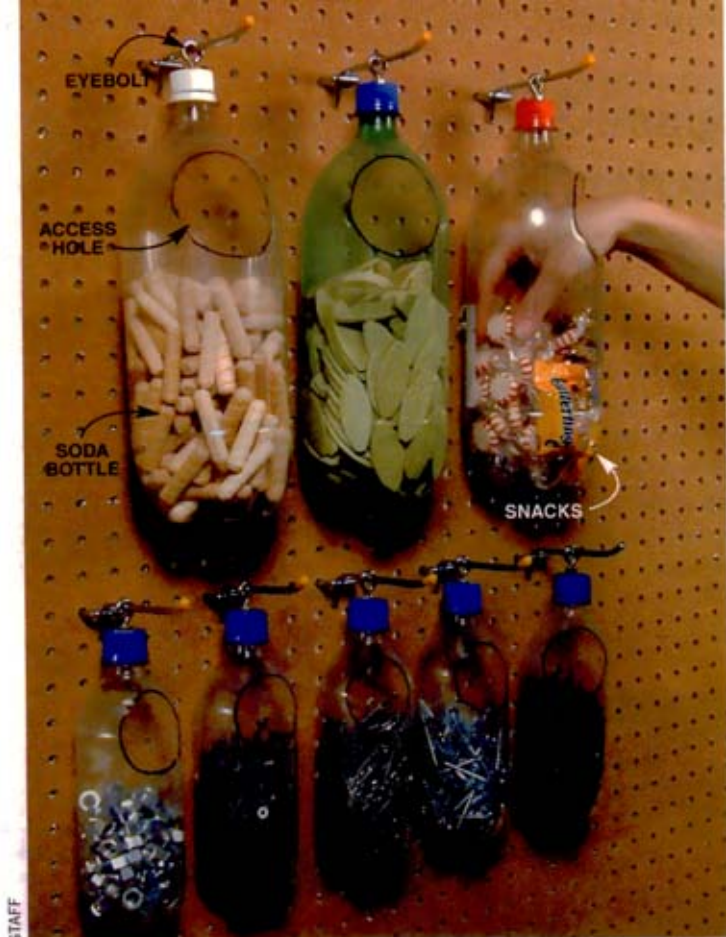
Cheap, Easy Storage

I found a quick, cheap and easy way to store lots of little stuff like biscuits, screws, wood plugs and the like. Drill a hole in the cap of a plastic soda bottle and insert an eyebolt. Secure the eyebolt with two nuts, one above and one inside the cap. Finally, cut a round hole in the shoulder of the bottle.

One cool thing about this storage system is if I knock one of these bottles off my workbench, all the stuff inside doesn't spill out. It gets trapped in the neck of the bottle rather than spilling out the opening.

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The Best \$250 Workbench

By Tom Caspar

This rock-solid workhorse is simply four easy-to-build 2x4-and-plywood boxes.

Quick, cheap, solid. You can't ask much more from a workbench, and this one delivers it all. Made of out nothing more than ordinary construction lumber, this durable, 250-lb. heavyweight has all the features of a master cabinetmaker's bench: a gigantic face vise, a slick tail vise and a rock-solid base.

You'll spend a measly \$150 at a home center on lumber and hardware. Add \$70 to \$150 for a face vise (see Sources, page 43). We used a cool-looking, top-notch model, but any big vise will do.

Tools and Materials

If you have limited tools, don't worry. It's perfectly possible to build this bench using nothing but a pair of sawhorses, a circular saw, hammer, drill, combination drill bit, router and flush-trim bit, hacksaw and socket set. That's it. A few more power tools (a miter saw, drill press, tablesaw and belt sander) make the job a lot easier, though.

The materials are nothing special, just 2x4s, 2x6s and two sheets of ordinary underlayment plywood (the kind with 1/8-in.-thick face veneer). Be picky when choosing your solid lumber. Look for boards that are straight, free of large knots and have full-width edges. Reserve your straightest boards for the top frame.

Preparing the Plywood

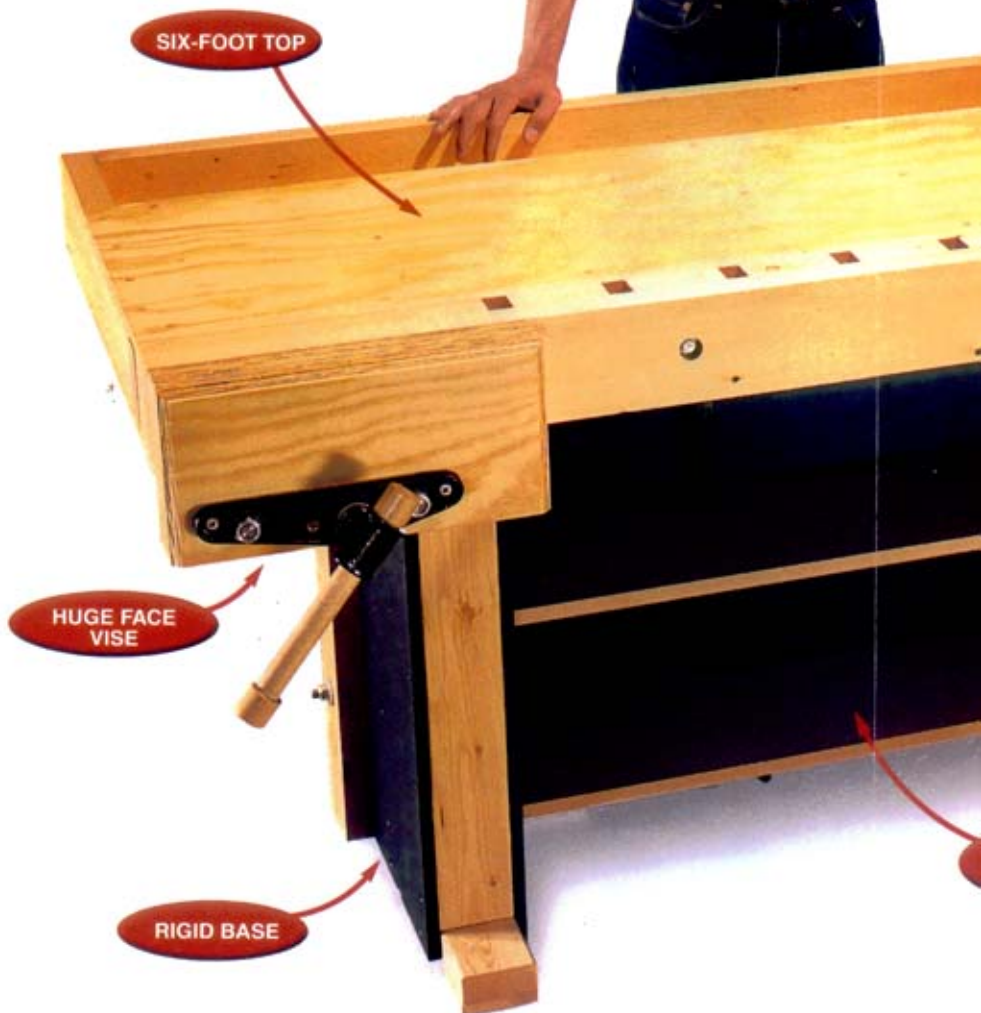
Start by cutting out the plywood panels. Factory edges are good enough, so you don't have many cuts to make. The few corners that have to be absolutely square are already done!

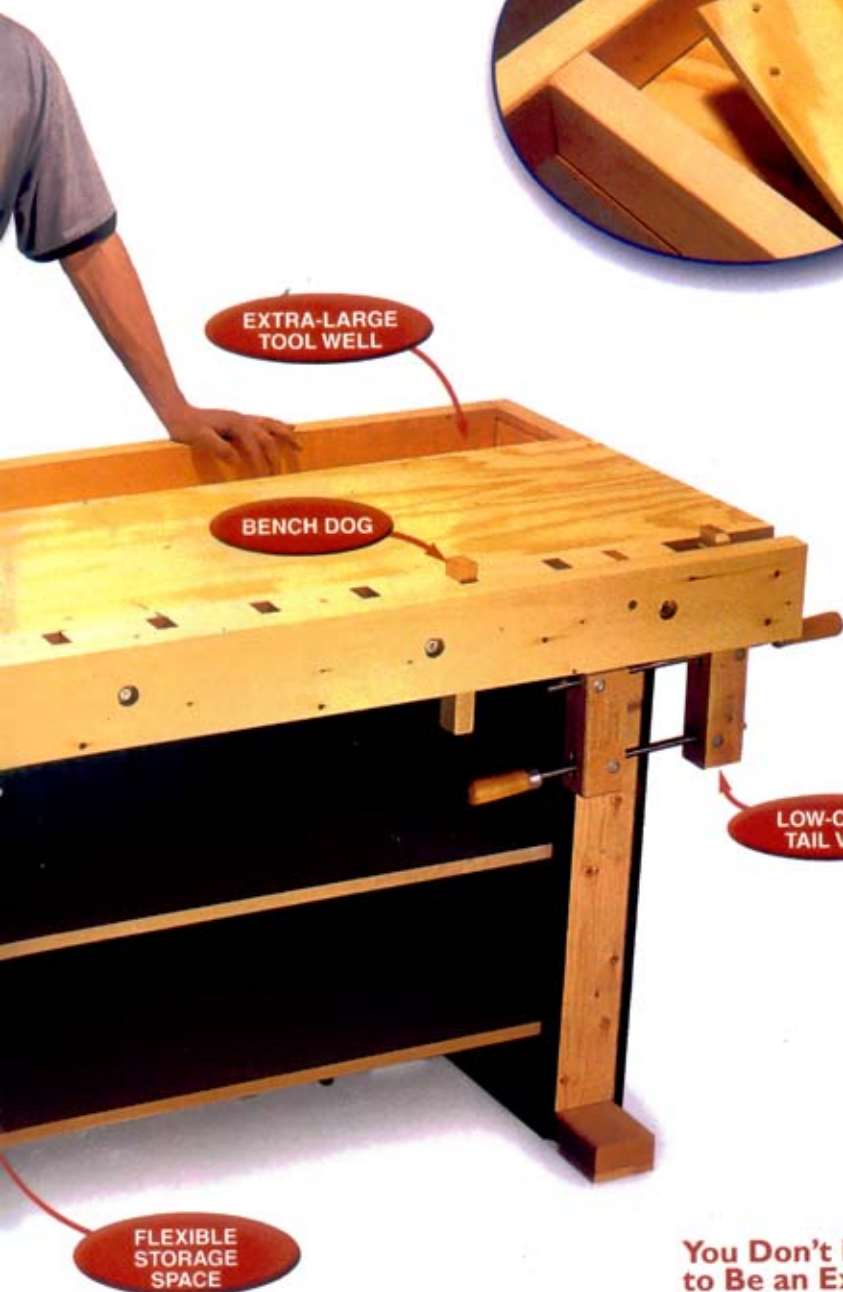
1. Draw the outlines of all the plywood panels (A1, B1, C1 and C2) on two sheets of plywood (see Fig. C, page 41 and the Cutting List, page 43).

2. Build a temporary cutting guide to fit your circular saw (Photo 1). It's easy to make by nailing together two overlapping 1x6s cut just over 6 ft. long (you'll use

these boards later as parts of the bench). The edge of the bottom board shows you exactly where the saw will cut, so you don't have to do any complicated measuring. The top board guides the saw. Nail some extra pieces of 1x6 under the overhang of the top board for balance.

Thrifty Construction

Rugged boxes made of nothing but 2x4s and plywood add up to a high-performance bench that costs peanuts to build.



Ingenious Tail Vise

Hold any project with no awkward clamps to get in the way.



You Don't Have to Be an Expert

Got a hammer, drill and circular saw? That's virtually all it takes to build this awesome workbench.

3. Place the cutting guide directly on the lines and cut all the panels.

4. Mark the screw holes (see Fig. D, page 41) on one side of an end panel (A1) and a center-section panel (B1).

5. Stack all four end panels on top of each other and drill 5/32-in.-diameter pilot holes all the way through them

(Photo 2). Gang up the center-section panels and drill through them, too.

6. Countersink *both* sides of all the screw holes. (The countersink on the back side removes torn fibers, so you get a tight glue joint.)

7. Paint one side and all four edges of the panels black. This covers up the crazy

figure and disguises the screws. A roller works great.

Building the End 2x4 Frame

The method for building each section is basically the same; you glue and screw plywood panels to a 2x4 frame. Once you get in gear, you'll bang out your

Workbench



1 Cut panels from construction-grade plywood with a quickie shop-made cutting guide. Even if you're off by a bit, these cuts are going to be accurate enough to build the bench.



2 Drill pilot holes through a stack of four panels at once. This is much faster than laying out and drilling one panel at a time.

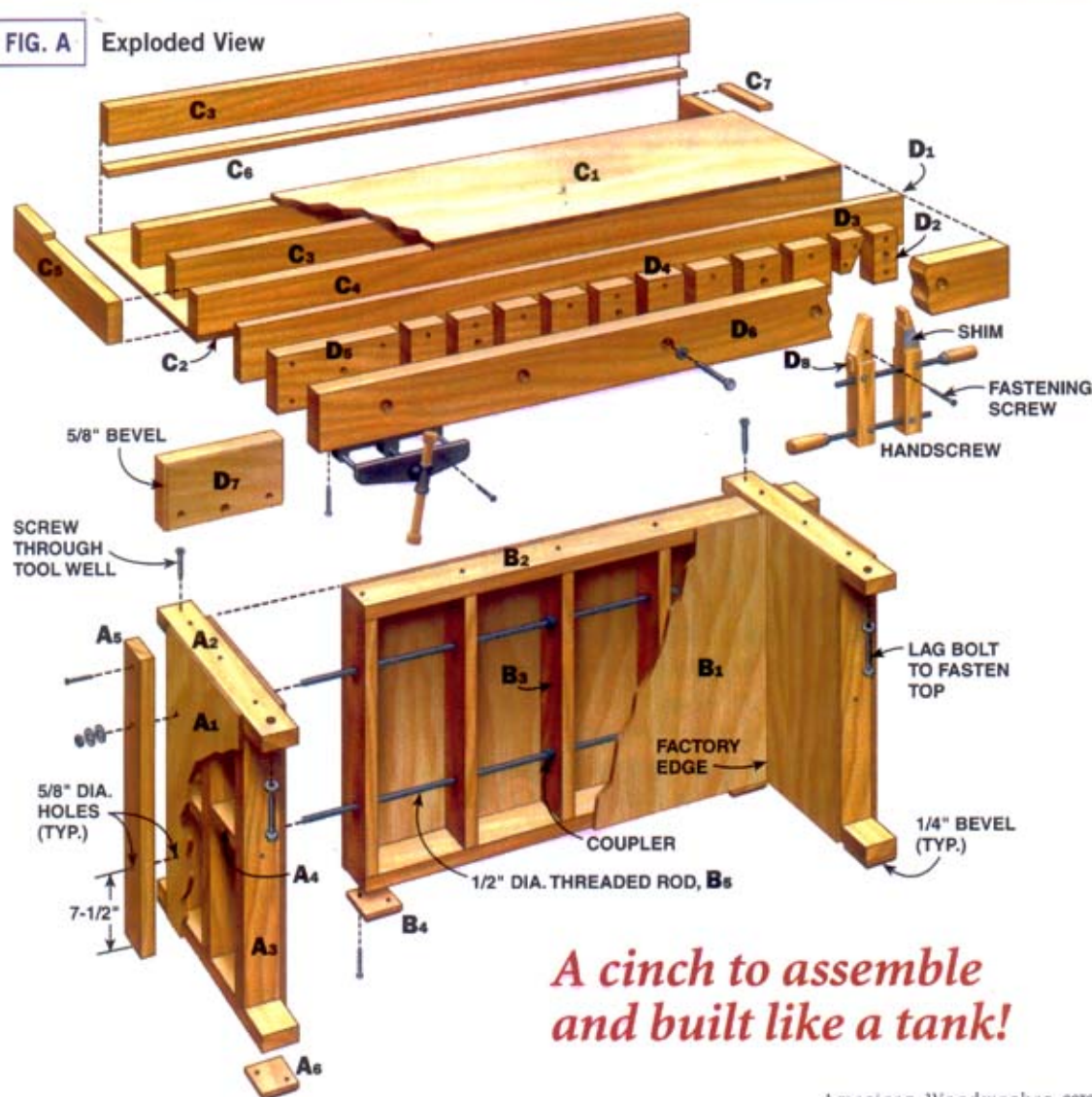


3 Measure the lengths of 2x4s directly from the plywood panels. The 2x4s should be fairly straight, but you don't have to machine them any further. All you do is crosscut.



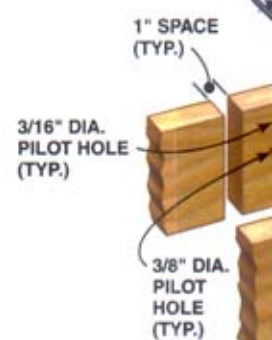

4 Nail the 2x4s together with a single nail at each joint. The joints don't have to be super tight or perfectly fitted. The strength of the box doesn't depend on complicated joinery.



5 Screw and glue plywood panels to the 2x4 frame. You won't need dozens of clamps because the screws do all the work. Painting the plywood black disguises all the ugly screw heads.



6 Join the knockdown base with humongous threaded rod. Nuts pull the sections so tight that the base is solid as the Rock of Gibraltar. After all, a workbench base can't be too strong, can it?

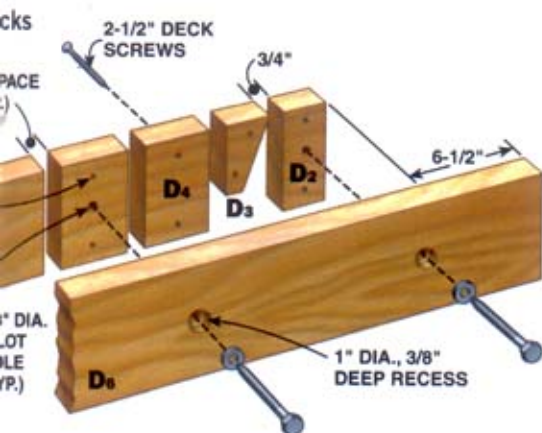

A Rock-Solid Foundation

A workbench that shimmies and shakes is a giant headache, especially when you use hand tools. It's supposed to stay still! The solution is having a heavy base that won't budge or twist out of shape when you push against it. Our hefty base weighs 125 lbs. and doesn't give an inch in any direction.



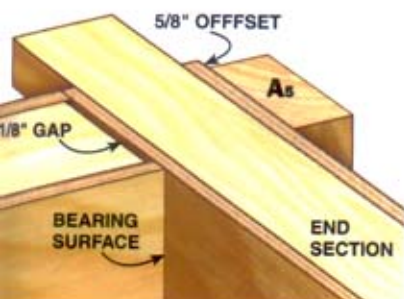
A solid-wood base can distort under pressure.

Fit Between Base Sections

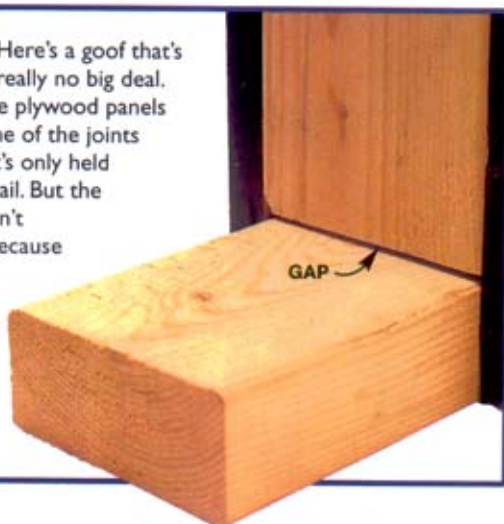
The center section is slightly undersized to fit between the bearing surfaces and the end section.



Oops!

Here's a goof that's really no big deal.

In the rush to glue the plywood panels on the 2x4 frames, one of the joints opened up. After all, it's only held together by a single nail. But the strength of the box isn't compromised at all, because its incredible rigidity comes from gluing plywood to the 2x4s, not the tightness of these joints. No sweat.



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Workbench



7 Rout the plywood top flush with the frame to make a large, even surface for the 1x6 rail. Select your best 2x4 for this front piece. It's one of the few in the bench that must be perfectly straight. It pays to dig through a large stack of 2x4s to find this gem.



8 Assemble the front rail one block at a time. Two outer blocks trap one angled jaw of a wooden handscrew: the bench's tail vise. Each succeeding block is spaced 1-in. apart, exactly the width of a combination square blade. These spaces become mortises for the bench dog.



9 Clamp the front rail to the benchtop and drill pilot holes for the lag bolts. The bolt heads are recessed so you have a completely smooth bench front.

bench in no time at all.

1. Cut the top and bottom 2x4s (A2). Measure the length of the legs (A3) directly from the plywood panel (Photo 3). Gang the top and bottom 2x4s at one end of the panel. The remaining distance from the 2x4s to the end of the panel gives you the exact length of the legs. Measure the spacers (A4) by the same method.

2. Cut the legs and spacers. Select the best looking wood for the face of the front legs. Mark "Front" clearly on the good face so you won't be confused in the heat of assembly!

3. Select one leg for the middle. With a combination square set to 3/4 in., draw a centerline down the length of its narrow edge, on both sides. Draw a centerline all the way around the middle of each top and bottom piece (see Fig. D, page 41). Line up the centerlines when assembling the frame.

4. Nail the frame together on a flat surface (Photo 4). The floor will do. Make sure all the top edges are as flush as possible, so you have an even surface all around to glue the panels

on. One nail at each joint is enough. (The nails only serve to keep the frame together long enough to glue on the panels.) Predrilling the nail holes through the outer members makes alignment much easier.

Assembling the Ends

It's time to get out the glue and go to town. You've got a lot of screws to drive, but there's no need to feel rushed. Once the panel is positioned the glue will stay wet long enough to run in all the screws.

1. Place one end panel on top of the frame. Nudge the frame square so it lines up with all four edges of the panel.

2. Tack down the panel to the frame with 4d nails at each corner. Turn the assembly over.

3. Run a large bead of glue along all the exposed edges of the 2x4s.

4. Place the other panel on top of the frame, align its edges with the frame and screw it down (Photo 5).

5. Turn the assembly over again, pry off the tacked-down piece of plywood with a hammer and pull out the nails. Then glue and screw the plywood back in place. Scrape

off the glue squeeze-out before it hardens.

6. Make the braces (A5) and drill 5/8-in.-diameter holes for the threaded rod (Fig. A, page 37). The thick braces spread out the enormous pressure of the nuts over a large surface.

7. Drill holes for the threaded rod through the plywood panels (see Fig. A, page 38). Rather than drill all the way through from one side, drill from both sides using the brace as a guide. This ensures that both holes are aligned so the rod will slip right through. Offset the brace 5/8 in. from the panel's edge (Detail 2, page 37).

8. Cut all the feet (A6 and B4). Bevel the bottom edges to protect them from splintering. Drill deeply countersunk pilot holes for the screws so the screw heads can't scratch your floor. Screw two feet onto the bottom of each end section.

Building and Assembling the Center Frame

This frame has two important differences from the end frames you just made. First, it's got holes for the threaded rod running through the

2x4s that you can't afford to forget! Second, the frame is slightly shorter than the panels. When you assemble the whole base, any warp or twist in the center frame's end 2x4s won't affect the tightness of the joints (see Detail 2, page 37).

1. Cut the rails (B2) 1/4 in. shorter than the width of the plywood panels. Then cut the stiles (B3).

2. Drill 1-in.-diameter holes in all the stiles. The holes are oversized to allow a threaded rod coupler to pass through (Fig. D, below right).

3. Nail the frame together, then tack a panel to it. Check your alignment. The frame's top and bottom edges are flush to the panel, but the ends of the frame are inset by 1/8 in. on both sides. Glue both panels, one at a time, as you did with the end sections. Attach the feet.

Assembling the Base

Two lengths of threaded rod (B5) bind the three base sections together with tremendous pressure. This large-diameter rod is surprisingly inexpensive, easy to disassemble and can't possibly come loose.

1. Cut the threaded rod with a hacksaw (see Cutting List, page 43). File a small bevel on the cut ends to enable the nuts to thread easier. Join two pieces of threaded rod together with a coupler and slide the long rod through the holes in the center section.

2. Stand the center section on a level surface. Slip the end sections over the threaded rod and slide on two washers (Photo 6). Tighten the nuts.

Assembling the Top

Select your straightest 2x4s for this frame so you'll get a relatively flat top. Put the best of the best in the front.

1. Predrill the pilot holes in the top and bottom panels (C1 and C2). Note that the holes in the upper surface of the top aren't simply countersunk, but counterbored deep enough to accept wood plugs (the plugs cover all the unsightly screw heads). The easiest way

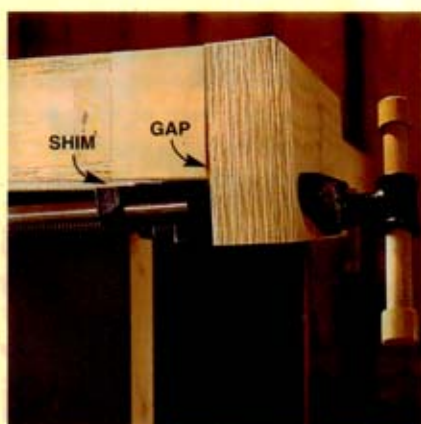

10 Rout the handscrew jaws so they're just a bit thinner than the opening of the front rail. Clamp a guide board to the handscrew and support the router with a T-shaped ledge and bridges of uncut wood.



11 Install the handscrew. Shim its moveable right jaw for a perfect sliding fit. You can easily raise or lower the height of the jaw to hold even the thinnest board on your bench.



12 Tilt the front vise by adding washers as shims to compensate for racking. To securely hold any board, a vise should first close at the top. As you tighten the screw, the face of the vise straightens out, applying even pressure over the entire surface of the board.

to do this is to use a combination bit made for a #10 screw (see Sources, page 43). It will counterbore a 3/8-in.-diameter hole for the plugs and drill a pilot hole at the same time.

2. Nail the frame together, but leave off the back stretcher (C3) and all of the spacers (C6 and C7). Tack the top (C1) to the frame with 4d nails at each corner. Note that the front of the top overhangs the front of the frame by about 1/8 in.

3. Glue and screw the bottom panel to the frame. Make sure it overhangs the front of the frame just like the top panel. Then turn the frame over and glue and screw the top.

4. Attach the back rail and spacer with deck screws. The spacers bring the back rail up to the same height as the top, making a large, level surface.

5. Trim the front overhang with a router and a flush-cutting bit (Photo 7). Glue wood plugs in the screw holes and sand them flush.

Building the Front

The front of the bench is a sandwich of 1x6s and 2x6s that can be ripped individually on a tablesaw to match

the thickness of the benchtop. This sawing removes the rounded edges on the top of the construction lumber, so your sandwich will have square edges on top and look like one gigantic solid piece when glued together. If you can't get at a tablesaw, this isn't absolutely necessary, but a flush front makes mounting the vise hardware much easier.

1. Cut one 1x6 and two 2x6s 6-ft. long (the length of the bench). Rip all three boards about 1/8-in. wider than the thickness of your benchtop.

2. Choose the best 2x6 as the outer board. Cut the spacers that form the dog holes (D2, D3 and D4) from the other 2x6. Drill two pilot holes for the deck screws in each spacer (Fig. A, Detail 1, page 38).

3. Starting at the right end of the bench, glue and screw the first spacer (D2), then clamp the handscrew around it to position the second spacer (Photo 8). Glue a small block (D8) on the left side of the handscrew to fill the void below the second spacer. Continue on down the line and cut the last spacer (D5) to fit.

4. Glue and screw the 1x6 (D1) along

the top of all the spacers, completing the three-part sandwich. Drill pilot holes for the lag screws with an extra-long bit (see Sources, page 43) and install the front rail on the bench (Photo 9). Clamp it in place so the top edge is proud of the benchtop. Level the front rail with a belt sander.

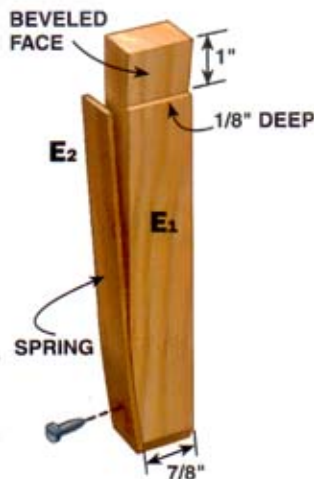
5. The jaws of the handscrew are too fat to fit in between the boards of the front rail. Use your router to make the jaws thinner, working from both sides (Photo 10). The final thickness of the jaws should be about 1/32 in. narrower than the opening in the front rail. The area you must remove is larger than the base of the router, so don't take it all off at once. Leave some areas uncut to support the router, then knock these bridges off with a chisel after you're done. Finish leveling the jaws with a block plane. Bevel the end of the right jaw with a small saw and chisel (same as the bench dog, Fig. E, page 43). This bevel improves the holding power of the handscrew, especially when the jaw is tilted backward at its maximum capacity.

6. Shim the right jaw of the handscrew with several layers of foil tape (the kind

Bench Dog

The dog leans slightly backward when you grip a board in the tail vise. Bevel the head to keep its gripping surface upright. The wooden spring keeps the dog at any height, freeing your hands to adjust the tail vise.

used for ventilation ducts) until it slides smoothly in the front rail opening (Photo 11). Then install the handscrew and secure it with a screw. Chances are, as the construction lumber dries out and shrinks you'll have to remove the handscrew and peel off some shims to keep it sliding well.

7. Glue the vise face together (D7) with cauls and plenty of clamps. Cut the pieces oversize and trim the glued block on a tablesaw, if you can. Turn the benchtop over and install the front vise hardware with the largest and longest screws you can manage (Photo 12). **AW**

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Amish Jelly Cupboard

The best
of both
worlds:

Pennsylvania is the home of fine stands of walnut trees and a rich tradition of Amish country furniture. We've updated an 1840s Amish jelly cupboard by substituting plywood for solid wood and tablesaw joinery for hand-cut dovetails.

Tools and Materials

If you've got a tablesaw and a router you're in business. You'll need a crosscut sled for your saw to accurately cut large pieces of plywood and a router table to make the molding. A dado set is a must for cutting the joints, but you won't need a pocket screw jig or special screws. We used a Forstner bit and standard flat-head tapping screws.

You can build this project with pre-planed 3/4-in. stock, so a jointer and planer are optional. You'll need straight boards, so pick your lumber carefully. This cupboard requires about 25 to 30 bd. ft. of solid walnut (\$125), 35 bd. ft. of a secondary wood such as yellow poplar (\$90), one sheet of 3/4-in. and one sheet of 1/4-in. veneer-core walnut plywood (\$200). (Plywood with a particle-board or MDF core isn't strong enough for this cabinet's joinery.) The hardware and pre-turned feet are an additional \$65.

Getting Started

Take a long, hard look at your sheet of 3/4-in. plywood before cutting it up. Its face is a series of bookmatched veneers separated by seams or glue lines. To create the illusion that your cabinet is made of glued-up solid wood, the front edges of the cupboard's sides and top should fall right on the seams. Our cutting diagram (Fig. L, page 66) is just one example of how to break up the sheet.

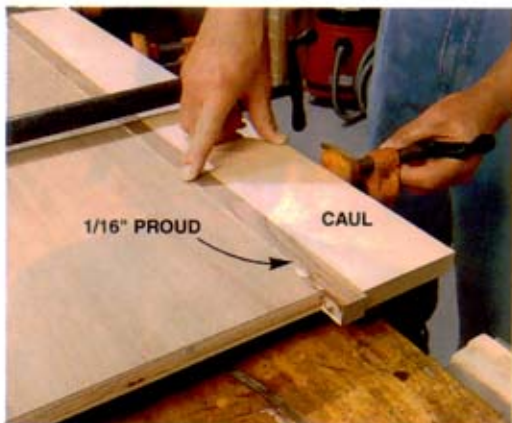
Before you cut up your solid wood, check its color against your plywood by wetting both with water, alcohol or mineral spirits. (If it doesn't match, you'll have some tricky staining work ahead. See Tips for Finishing Walnut in AW #75, October 1999, page 60.) Choose the boards that match best for the edging.

Edging the Sides and Bottom

1. Cut the sides (B1) and bottom panel (H1) to exact width and rough length (see Fig. L, page 66).
2. Cut the edging (B2 and H2) from boards that are 3/4-in. thick.
3. Glue the edging to the sides and bottom panels (Photo 1). Insert a 3 to 4-in.-wide caul between the clamp and the edging to spread out the pressure. The edging is 1/8-in. thicker than the plywood, so you don't have to worry now about making it perfectly even. But before you tighten the clamps, make sure the edging is proud of the plywood on both sides. Remove the squeezed-out glue before it dries.
4. Even up the edging with the plywood

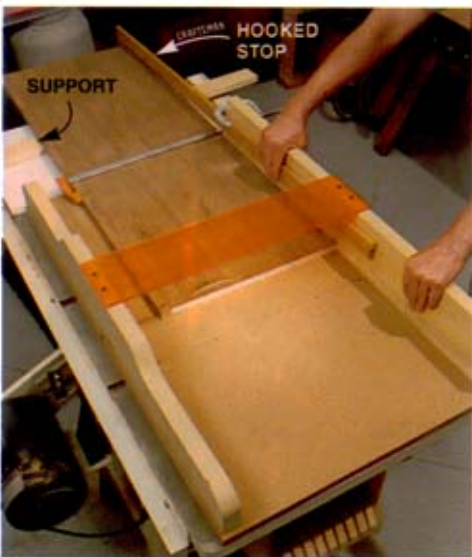

Glue solid edging to the plywood panels. Spread clamp pressure with a caul. A tight glue joint makes your case look like it's built entirely out of solid wood.

Even up the edging with a router jig. You can get darn close with the router, but to avoid cutting into the thin veneer, take the last fraction off by sanding or scraping.



3

Square the plywood sides with a crosscut sled. This tablesaw jig (see AWW #75, October 1999, page 38) is by far the best way to make an accurate cut on wide panels. Sides that aren't square will throw the whole case out of whack.

(Photo 2). This isn't a job for a belt sander, because it's too easy to accidentally cut through the plywood's thin veneer. A router jig works great. Make it extra long to offset the weight of the router. Install a dado or planer bit (see Sources, page 67) in the router and set it a paper thickness above the base of the jig. This style of router bit makes a cleaner cut than a standard straight bit.

5. Crosscut the sides and bottom to exact length with a crosscut sled (Photo 3).

Building the Web Frames

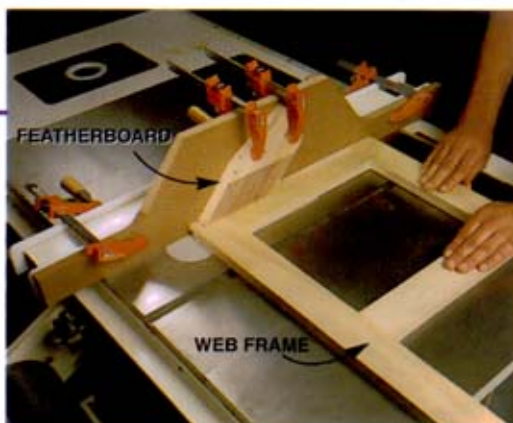
1. Cut the fronts and backs (C1) to the exact width and 1/4-in. longer than the final length. Cut the stretchers (C2) to exact width and length.
2. Join the web frame parts with homemade spline or biscuits. Mark centerlines for biscuits (Fig. C, page 60) and cut #20 biscuit slots.
3. Glue the two web frames. Be sure they're not twisted.
4. Crosscut the web frames to exact length.

Cutting the Joints

Dadoes

1. Cut dadoes for the drawer dividers (C3) in the web frames (see Fig. C, page 60, for all joinery dimensions).
2. Cut identical dadoes in the case's sides to hold the lower web frame and the bottom.

Cut rabbets on the ends of the web frame with a dado set. Using a featherboard keeps your hands out of harm's way and guarantees a consistent cut, which is essential for a tight-fitting joint.

Squaring Jig

This simple device makes glue up so easy it's worth its weight in gold. Make four from MDF or plywood and you'll be guaranteed a square case.



5

Glue and screw one web frame at a time to the cabinet side. Hold each frame exactly upright with large squaring jigs clamped in place.



Pocket screws are a great substitute for long clamps.

Rabbets

1. Cut rabbets on the ends of both web frames (Photo 4). Note that the two web frames have rabbets on different faces. When you cut the rabbets, the dados are facing up on one web frame and facing down on the other.
2. Cut rabbets to hold the upper web frame in the top of both cabinet sides.
3. Cut rabbets on the ends of the bottom panel (H1).
4. Cut rabbets to hold the back (Fig. D, page 60).

Screw Pockets

1. Use a Forstner bit (see Sources, page 67) in your drill press, or a spade bit in a portable drill, to bore the large relief holes in both web frames and the bottom panel (Fig. H, page 61). Setting up a fence on a large auxiliary table makes this operation much easier on a drill press (see Drill Press Table in AW #86, April 2001, page 111).

Add the second side to the cabinet. You don't need dozens of clamps and cauls to glue this wide case together. Pocket screws do all the work.

Attach the top web frame. It fits right on top of the drawer dividers and the sides of the case.



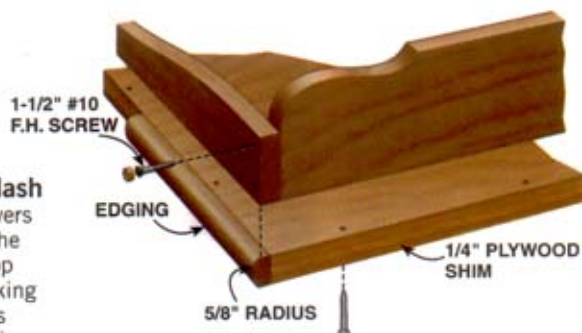

The backsplash covers the joint between the built-up plywood top and its edging, making the top look like it's made entirely of 1-in.-thick solid wood.

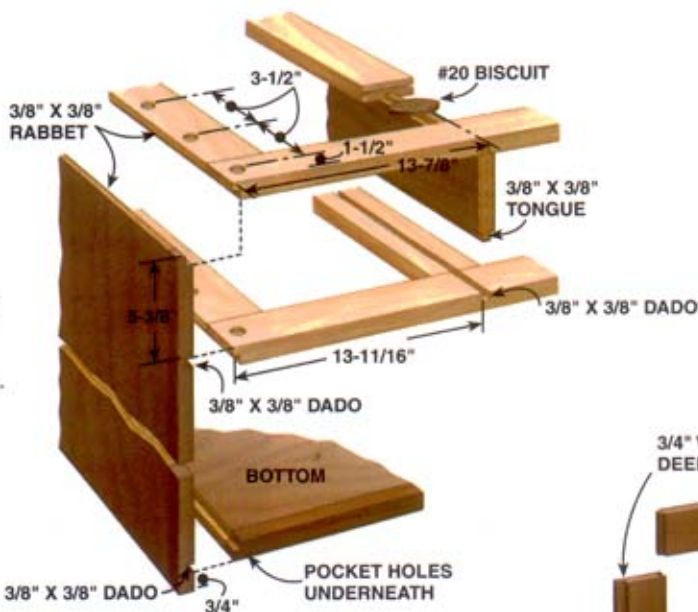

All you need is a dado set to make the major joints of this large case.

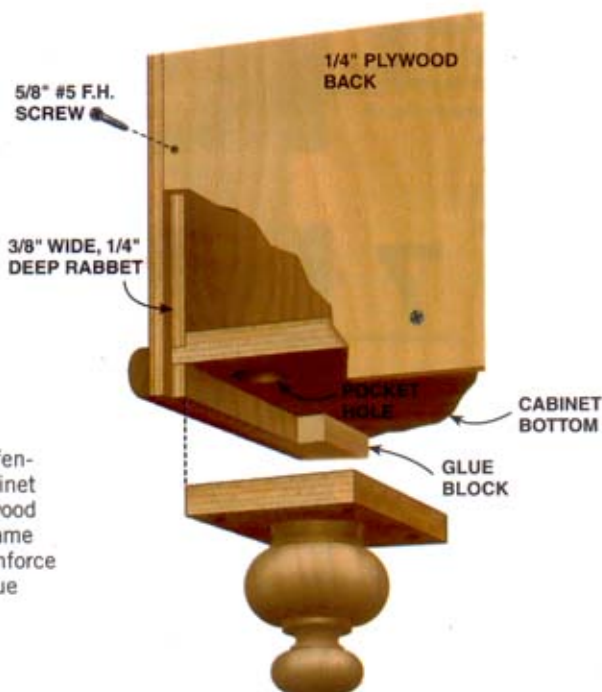

The secret to stiffening this large cabinet is to screw a plywood back to all the frame members and reinforce the joints with glue blocks.

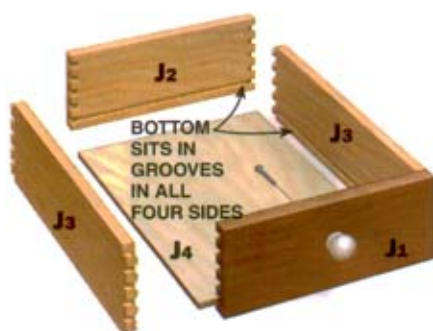

The dovetails work out perfectly on a standard router jig.

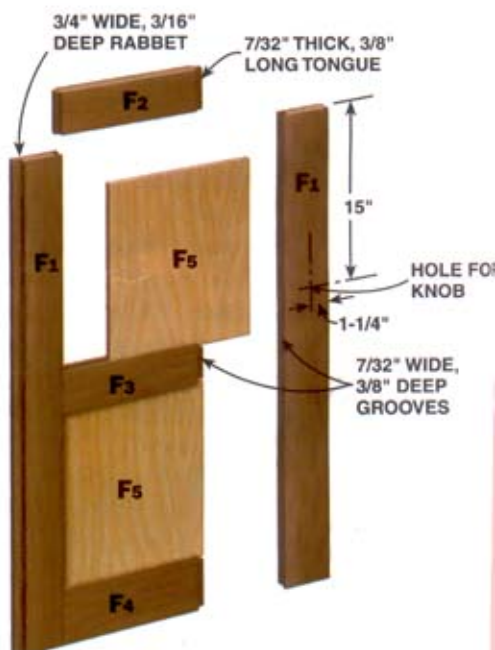

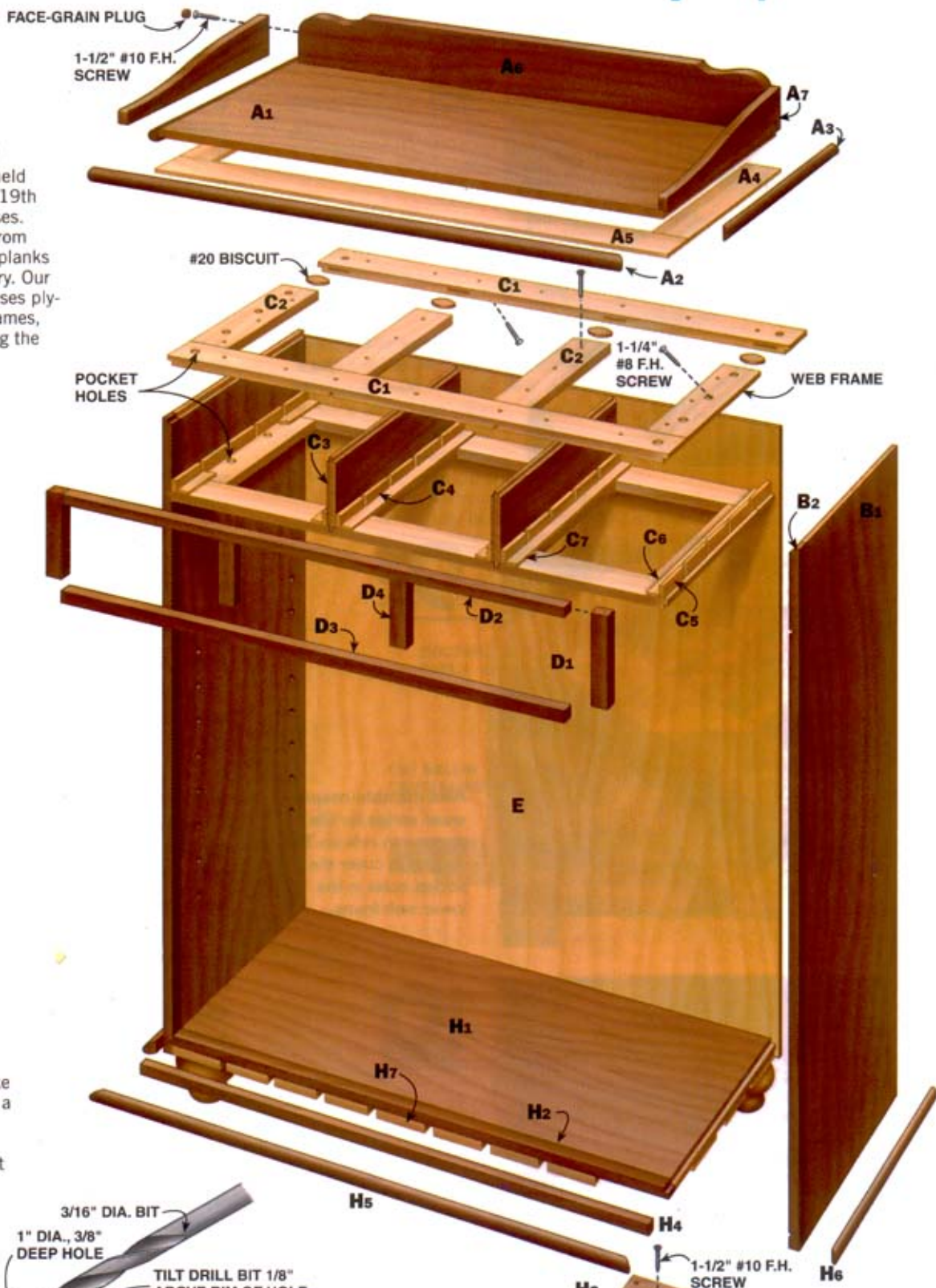
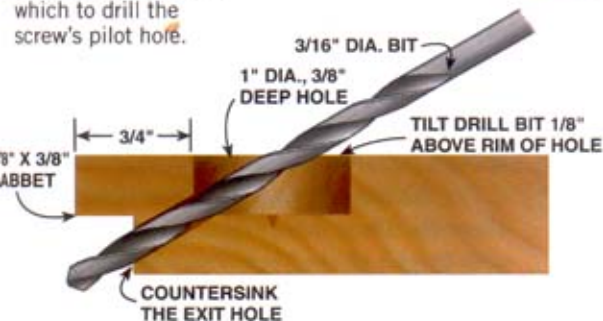

Pocket Hole Dimensions

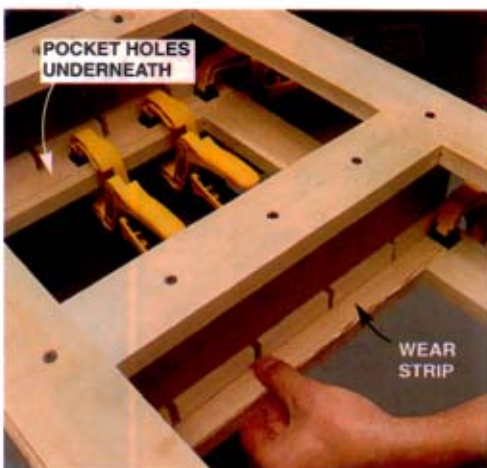
It's fairly easy to make pocket holes without a jig. The large 1-in. hole automatically gives you the angle at which to drill the screw's pilot hole.

2. Use a portable drill to make the pilot holes. Countersink the exit holes so the joint will draw up tight.

3. Drill and countersink screw holes for the drawer dividers through the dados in both web frames (Fig. G, page 61).

Gluing the Case

1. Build four squaring jigs (Fig. A, page 59). Dry assemble the entire case, one piece at a time, and drill pilot holes into the sides for the pocket screws. Use the jigs to hold the pieces together.

2. Glue and screw the lower web frame to one side using two squaring jigs (Photo 5). Then glue and screw the bottom in place with two more jigs.

3. Install the upper web frame, but don't glue it in. Measure the space between the web frames and cut the drawer dividers (C3) to fit. Cut rabbets on the dividers. Remove the web frame.

4. Glue and screw the second side (Photo 6).

5. Remove the squaring jigs and stand the cabinet upright. Glue and screw the drawer dividers to the lower web frame, then glue and screw the upper web frame (Photo 7).

Stiffening the Case

1. Cut the back (E) to fit. Drill pilot holes for the screws (Fig. D, page 60) and install the back.

2. To stiffen the joint between the sides and lower web frame, glue short blocks (C4 and C5) in place (Photo 8). (These blocks do double duty as drawer guides.) Don't use screws or nails because their heads can chew up your drawer as it slides by.

3. Turn the case over and glue a series of short glue blocks (H7) between the bottom and the sides. Add more blocks underneath the front edge of the bottom (Fig. G, page 61). Be sure to leave 4 in. of room at each corner for the foot-mounting blocks (H3).

Drawer Wear Strips and Frames

1. Glue the wear strips on the web frames (Photo 9). The outer strips cover the pocket holes.

2. Cut the frame ends (D1) to size and glue them on. Their inner edges must be even with the glue blocks. Their outer edges extend 1/16-in. proud of the case's side. After the

glue dries, even up these edges with the same router jig you used for edging the plywood.

3. Cut the long top and bottom pieces (D2 and D3) to fit between the side pieces (Photo 10) and glue them on. Carefully position the bottom piece even with the wear strips.
4. Cut the middle pieces (D4) to fit. Glue them on after fine-tuning the width so both sides are flush with the drawer guides.

Making the Bottom Molding

1. Saw three 1/2 in. x 1-in. molding blanks that are a couple of inches extra long. Make a 1-in. thick, 3-in.-wide temporary support board by gluing together 3/4-in. and 1/4-in. plywood. (They may add up to only 15/16 in., but that's okay.) Attach the molding blanks to the support board with double-faced tape (Photo 11).
2. Install a 5/8-in.-radius bit (see Sources, page 67) in your router table (Fig. J, at right). The opening in your router table must be at least 1-3/4-in. dia. to handle this bit. Rout the molding and pry it off the support board.
3. The front molding is attached to a backer (H4). Cut the backer to fit flush with the sides of the case.
4. Cut miters on the front molding (H5) to line up with the ends of the backer. Glue the two together and even up their top edges.
5. Glue this assembly to the case, even with the bottom edges of the glue blocks. This leaves 1/2 in. of the bottom's front edge exposed as a stop for the doors.
6. Cut the side moldings (H6) 1 in. or so longer than their final length. Miter one end of each piece and test the fit (Photo 12). Tweak the miter if necessary, then cut the molding to length and glue it on.

Attaching the Feet

1. Cut the foot mounting blocks (H3) from leftover walnut plywood. Drill and counter-sink holes through the blocks for screws to attach the feet and the blocks to the case. Drill holes in the center for 1-in. dowels.
2. Glue and screw the feet to the blocks (see Sources, page 67). Use epoxy because it works better than other glues on end grain.
3. Once the glue is dry, continue drilling the dowel hole 2-in. deeper into the foot. Glue in the dowel with epoxy (Photo 13).

Shape the narrow moldings on a router table. Tape two pieces to a built-up, 1-in.-thick support board so your fingers are well away from the action.

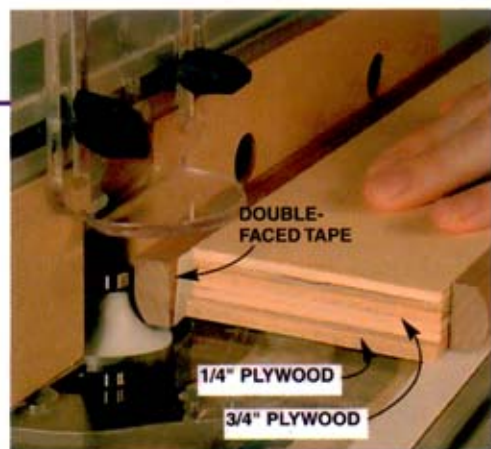
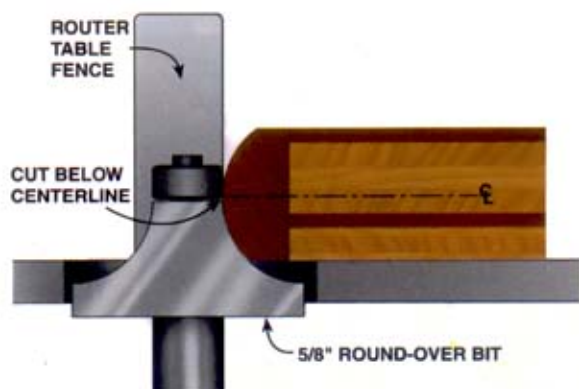

TIP: Molding Setup

When you round the top and bottom of a molding, set the cutter slightly *below* the centerline so a small uncut section in the middle of the molding rides along the fence. This ensures a smooth, continuous cut and prevents snipe at the end of the molding. Sand the molding when you're done to round over the uncut section.

Fit the molding to the bottom of the case. Molding protects the fragile ends of the plywood sides from everyday wear and tear, such as bumps from a vacuum or snags from a dust cloth.





13

Epoxy a large dowel into a commercially made foot to securely attach it to the mounting block. It's hard to get a large dowel to fit tightly, but epoxy will adequately fill the gaps for a good bond. It also adheres to the foot's end grain.



14

Glue the plywood mounting blocks and feet to the case. The feet are often a weak spot in a large case, but these are built to last.



15

Fasten the top to the case. The backsplash is screwed, but not glued, to the top. You can remove it before finishing the top so you won't have so many nasty corners to deal with.

4. Glue and screw the mounting blocks and feet to the bottom of the case (Photo 14).

Making the Top and Backsplash

1. Cut the top panel (A1) to size. Cut the shims (A4 and A5) from leftover plywood. They can be pieced together from short stuff.
2. Glue the shims underneath the top. They overhang the top by 1/8 in. all around. Use a router and flush-trim bit to even them up.
3. Glue mitered edging to the *front* of the top. Even it up with the router jig you used on the sides of the case. Then add edging to the sides of the top and rout it even. (You can't even up all three pieces of edging in one shot because the jig can't cut into a corner.) Radius the edging on the router table with the same setup used on the bottom molding (Fig. J, Page 63).
4. Rip the backsplash pieces and trim to length. Cut the curves with a jigsaw or band-saw (Fig. K, page 65) and fair them with a half-round file.
5. Counterbore holes for plugs to cover the screws that join the backsplash together. Face-grain plugs blend in better than end-grain plugs. You can buy them ready-made or make your own with a tapered plug cutter (see Sources, page 67).
6. Set up the backsplash pieces with the squaring jigs and glue and screw them together. Glue and even up the plugs.
7. Remove the 1/4-in. plywood back from the case. Drill angled holes through the top web frame for the screws that'll fasten down the top (Fig. G, page 61). To get the angle right, start the holes from the *bottom* side of the web frame. Countersink quite deeply, so there's no chance of the screw heads catching on the drawers. Fasten the backsplash to the top and the top to the case (Photo 15).

Making the Drawers

1. Cut the parts to fit your case. Rip all the pieces 1/16-in. narrower than the opening to allow for seasonal movement. For a tight-fitting drawer, the fronts should be 1/32 in., or less, shorter than each opening. Make the backs 1/16-in. shorter than the fronts. This tapers the drawer box, making it easier to fit.
2. Cut grooves for the drawer bottoms on the tablesaw and rout the parts on a dovetail jig (Photo 16).

3. Fit the bottoms and glue the drawers together. Glue stops (J5) at the back of the case so the drawers stop flush with the front.

Making the Doors

1. Cut all the parts to the sizes indicated in the Cutting List, page 66. Your doors will be oversized 1/4 in. in length and 1/8 in. in width. Cut grooves for the 1/4-in.-plywood panels in the stiles (F1) and rails (F2, F3 and F4). Most 1/4-in. plywood is actually 1/32-in. thinner. A dado set can't make a groove that narrow, but two passes with a standard blade works just fine.

2. Cut tenons to fit (see Foolproof Tenons, AW #88, August 2001, page 66). Assemble the door and measure the distance from the bottom of one groove to the bottom of the opposite groove. Cut panels that are 1/16-in. shorter in length and width than these measurements. Glue the doors (Photo 17).

3. To custom-fit your case, cut the doors in two stages. Aim for a 1/16-in. gap at the top and bottom and in between the doors. First, trim both ends on your crosscut sled (this will even up all the rails and stiles). Second, take a little bit off the sides.

Hanging the Doors

1. Cut rabbets in the outer stiles with a dado set (Fig. F, page 60). Make the rabbets the full depth of the hinge when closed (about 3/16 in.) and 3/4-in. wide.

2. Cut the continuous hinge to length at the nearest knuckle, butt it into the rabbet and drill pilot holes with a self-centering bit (see Sources, page 67). This indispensable bit is key to successfully hanging the door because it automatically centers the pilot holes. Install a few screws.

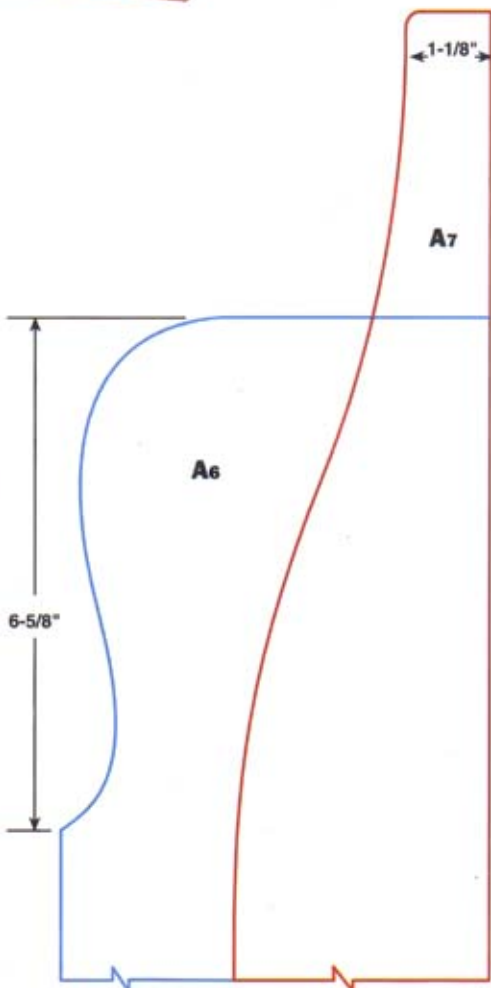
3. Lay the case on its back and support the door on a stool (Photo 18). Line up the opened hinge so it's flush with the inside edge of the case. Install a screw at either end and try out the door. If it closes perfectly, congratulations! If it doesn't, loosen one of the screws, shift the door and put two new screws in neighboring holes. Now retighten the first screws. It's that easy.

Rout the drawer parts on a standard dovetail jig. We've sized the drawers so the dovetails come out with perfect half-pins at the top and bottom.

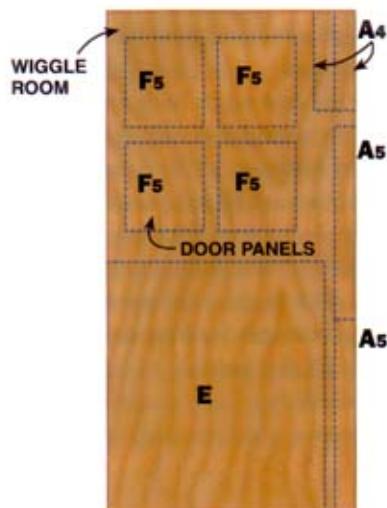
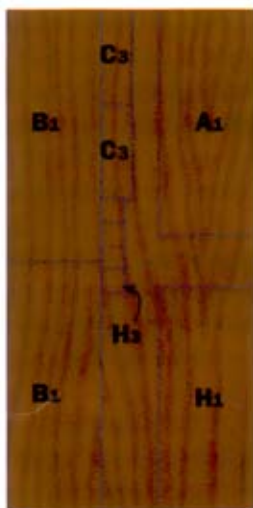
Plywood Cutting Diagrams

All of the pieces for this cupboard, except for the drawer bottoms, can be cut from two pieces of plywood. On the 1/4-in. sheet, position the door panels anywhere you like to get balanced and pleasing figure. You'll have plenty of room to try several options.

Installing Hardware and Finishing

1. Drill holes for the drawer and doorknobs (Fig. F, page 60).
2. Drill holes for the shelf pins.
3. Install magnetic catches for the doors.
4. Remove the top, back and doors to make finishing easier.
5. Dye the maple feet (see Sources, page 67).
6. Walnut looks great under almost any kind of finish. We used Minwax Antique Oil to bring out the handsome figure.
7. Bright white ceramic knobs are a striking contrast to the cupboard's dark walnut (see Sources, page 67). (The original Amish cupboard that inspired ours has ceramic knobs, as well.) Install the knobs.
8. Start making jelly! **AW**

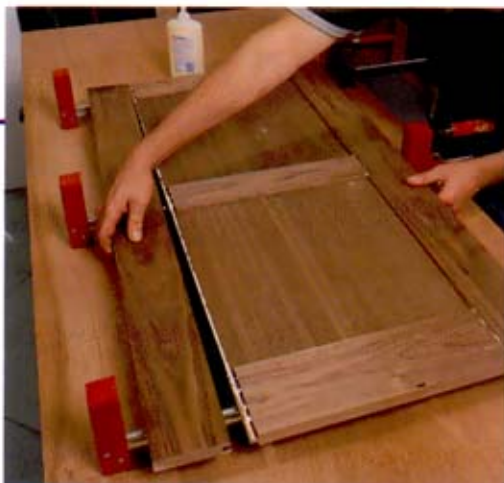

Glue the plywood panels and the rails into the door stiles. The joinery is simple tongue and groove, which is plenty strong for this large door because all the parts are glued together.

Hang the door with a continuous hinge. Unusual? Sure, but it's slick. It's easy to install, with no fussy mortises, just a simple rabbet; plus it's durable and rigid, which helps keep the door flat.



Oops!

I was a cheapskate, and regretted it. The first time I made the doors for this cabinet I used up the tail end of my walnut pile. The mismatched figure looked nasty! I had to buy a whole new bunch of lumber and build a new pair of doors. Lesson learned: Don't skimp when you buy lumber.

TOOL TEST Sharpening Machines

Are they better than a grinder and stones?

By Tom Caspar

I know a guy who uses a belt sander to sharpen his hand tools! Don't laugh, it works—sort of. There are dozens of setups you can use to sharpen tools. Many woodworkers have grown accustomed to using a high-speed grinder and stones, but a grinder can burn your tools and stones are a hassle. Wouldn't you like a single, foolproof machine that could do it all?

The Test

We took a hard look at horizontal and vertical sharpening machines to see if they fit the bill. With the aid of a panel of intermediate-skill, non-professional woodworkers, we rated the machines on how well they performed four basic tasks:

1. Lapping

You only have to do it once, but it's gotta be done right. Lapping makes the back of a tool dead flat and highly polished (Photo 1). You must remove all of the factory-made milling marks about 1 in. back from the tip. This tedious and exacting process is a bear when done by hand. If you can get a machine to help, by all means, go for it.

2. Coarse grinding

You won't need to do it very often, but coarse grinding is essential for restoring old and abused tools. It removes a lot of metal to form an approximate bevel (Photo 2).

You don't need to precisely calibrate the grinding angle, but an easily adjustable, wide tool rest offers the most control.

3. Medium grinding

You'll renew the bevel made in this operation quite often (Photo 3). At this point, grinding becomes fussier. The bevel you produce should be absolutely straight across and accurately angled to within a few degrees. This makes honing much easier. Machines with good tool rests and jigs are easiest to use, although you can get decent results without a jig if you have a steady hand.

4. Honing

The faster this goes the better, because you'll be honing over and over again. You refine the tip of the tool until it's razor sharp at a single precise angle (Photo 4). Three things are critical: controlling the angle of the bevel, defining the shape of the edge (dead straight or, in the case of some plane blades, very slightly curved) and producing a mirror-smooth polish. Machines that can do all three things well have a good tool rest, a good jig and fine abrasives.





Planer and Jointer Knife Grinding

In addition to sharpening hand tools, you can renew the edges of planer and jointer knives on some sharpening machines. They should offer both coarse and medium grinding because you'll have to remove a lot of steel to get past deep nicks. Good machines have easily calibrated adjustments, well-machined jigs and clear instructions.

Wouldn't you like one machine that could do it all?

The Acid Test

Can each machine perform all the basics?

Vertical-Wheel Machines

Three vertical machines are very similar in design. A fourth, the Tormek, is much more sophisticated. Here's how the three basic machines performed as a class. For details on individual machines, see the chart on pages 80 and 81.

Lapping

Barely acceptable. Using the side of the large wheel, it's a slow operation yielding imperfect results. Maintaining the side of the wheel as a flat surface is difficult.

Coarse grinding

Okay. Use the dry wheel, but upgrade the tool rest (see Sources, page 80). The standard tool rest is too small and difficult to adjust. Toss it.

Medium grinding

Pretty good. You can't overheat an edge on the wet wheel, but you might have trouble making the edge straight without a jig (see Recommended Accessory, at right).

Honing

Forget it. The wet wheels are too coarse to produce a polished edge, so you'll still be honing with stones or sandpaper.

The Tormek

A favorite with hand tool users for years, the Tormek is a complete sharpening system at a fairly steep price (\$390). You can go all the way from a rough to a finely honed edge, although coarse grinding and lapping on the wet wheel are fairly slow. Unlike the other vertical machines, you can change the grit of the wet wheel back and forth from medium to fine with an accessory stone grader (\$22). Yes, it does work.

Renewing a bevel through medium grinding is quite easy using the Tormek's sliding jig. You use the same jig to hone on a second wheel, which is basically a leather strop. All strops round over edges a bit, but if you've got the angles worked out and you don't overdo it, you'll get a razor-sharp tool.

The Bottom Line

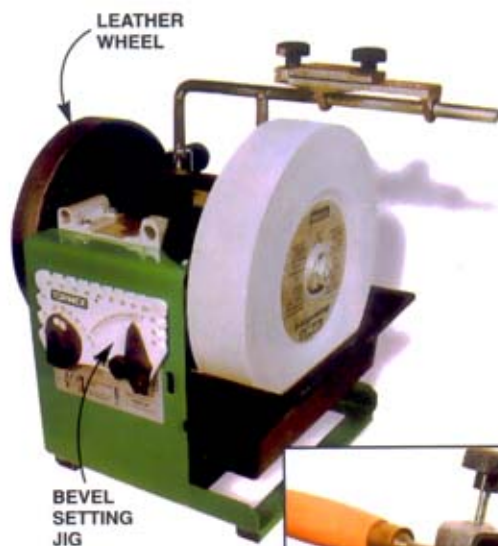
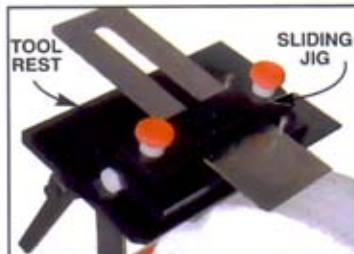
Vertical-wheel sharpening machines are by no means complete systems. The basic vertical machines are best at preparing an edge for honing. Stick to the wet wheel, and you'll never burn an edge. They're a reasonable substitute for a high-speed grinder and a coarse stone, but aside from the Tormek, not a substitute for fine stones.



Vertical sharpening machines have both a slow-speed, coarse-grit wet wheel and a high-speed grinder.

Recommended Accessory

You'll make straighter edges on any vertical machine by adding an Accusharp tool rest and grinding jig (\$33 to \$40, see Sources, page 80).



The Tormek features two slow-speed wheels: a wet one for grinding and a leather one for honing. There's a well-designed jig available for just about every woodworking tool (\$13 to \$60 each).

Horizontal-Wheel Machines

Most of these machines are very simple: water drips from a reservoir on a rotating 1,000-grit waterstone. Reliant and Delta offer an additional high-speed grinder. The Veritas, however, is a dry, sandpaper-based system. Here's how the wet machines performed as a class. For details on individual machines, see the chart on pages 80 and 81.

Lapping

Acceptable. Use the surface of the large wheel, either while it's spinning or stationary. You'll get a higher polish than a vertical-wheel machine produces, but it's still not shiny enough.

Coarse grinding

Okay, but only possible on the two machines with a high-speed grinder. Upgrade their tool rests (see Sources, page 80) and you'll be much better off.

Medium grinding

Good. The wet wheels work fine, but the standard tool rests on the single-wheel machines are too narrow and not equipped with jigs. It takes practice to make a consistent bevel. Delta's jig works well. Some machines offer auxiliary tool rests for planer knives that are wider and accept a neat aftermarket jig (see Recommended Accessory, at right).

Honing

Acceptable, using the same wet wheel. Your tools will be sharp enough for general-purpose work, but you'll have to finish with stones or sandpaper for truly keen edges.

Veritas Power Sharpening System

The Veritas is quick and clean, but this convenience comes at a pretty stiff price (\$395). Clamp your tool in a jig, set the tool rest into one of seven pre-marked indents to establish the bevel angle and you're all set. Changing grits by swapping discs only takes a few seconds. The honing disc is thinner than the coarser ones, so when you switch to the finest disc, you automatically raise the bevel angle by one degree. Now you can form a perfect, shiny bevel on the tip of your tool. This is a dry system, so you won't make a wet mess. Hook up a vacuum to keep your shop free of grinding dust.

The Bottom Line

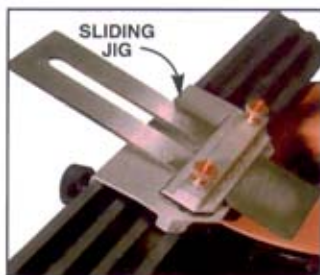
Horizontal wheels are finer than vertical wheels, so you get a sharper edge. A horizontal machine is a good substitute for a high-speed grinder and medium stones. The Makita (with accessories) and Veritas can replace your fine stones, as well.



Horizontal machines have slow-speed, medium-grit wet wheels. The Delta and Reliant come with additional high-speed grinders.

Recommended Accessory

Make super-sharp edges on the Makita, Delta and Reliant with a 2 In 1 guide (\$15, see Sources, page 80). Grind your edge on the machine's fine wheel, then add a roller to the 2 In 1 guide and continue honing on your favorite fine and superfine stones.



The Veritas Power Sharpening System is a completely dry machine. You can easily interchange a full range of self-stick sandpaper discs, good for up to 200 sharpenings apiece (\$3 to \$5 each).



Recommendations

If you don't mind getting a bit wet, most sharpening machines are good replacements for high-speed grinders. But only a few machines can replace all your stones, and they cost almost \$400.

What Will Work for You?

- *If you've got a high-speed grinder and hate overheating your edges.* You're in the market for any wet machine. It's impossible to burn an edge with one.
- *If you don't have a grinder.* Look for a sharpening machine that has one, but count on upgrading the tool rest.
- *If you don't sharpen often or need a super edge.* Look at the least expensive horizontal-wheel machines.
- *If you prefer honing on a stone without a jig.* Pick a vertical-wheel machine. It creates a hollow-ground bevel which is easy to balance on a stone.
- *If you use Japanese tools.* Go with a horizontal-wheel machine. Japanese laminated blades should be ground with a flat bevel only.
- *If you use carving tools.* Go for the wet Tormek and its jigs. It's possible to burn a very thin edge on the dry Veritas.
- *If you want to sharpen nicked planer and jointer knives.* You better have some patience. Setting up the jig and removing a lot of steel takes time.

Do You Need One At All?

Not really. Here's a complete, low-cost alternative sharpening system:

Lapping

A piece of 1/4-in. plate glass, sandpaper and a low-tack spray adhesive. Cost: about \$10.

Coarse and Medium Grinding

A slow-speed grinder with white wheels, an aftermarket tool rest and a diamond dresser. Cost: about \$155.

Honing

A combination 1,000/6,000 waterstone and a honing jig. Cost: about \$40.

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Improved Cordless Drill

You've got to hand it to DeWalt. Instead of plunking the latest, greatest battery into an old drill and calling it new, they completely redesigned every other component of their top-selling line of XRP drill/drivers. These drills are new from the battery up, and they exhibit impressive low-end torque and faster top speeds than other cordless drills.

The XRP family includes 12-volt, 14-volt and 18-volt drill drivers. We think the new 12-volt DW980, which has a 1/2-in.-capacity chuck, infinitely variable speeds from 0 to 1,800 rpm and 22 clutch settings is the best choice for general woodworking.

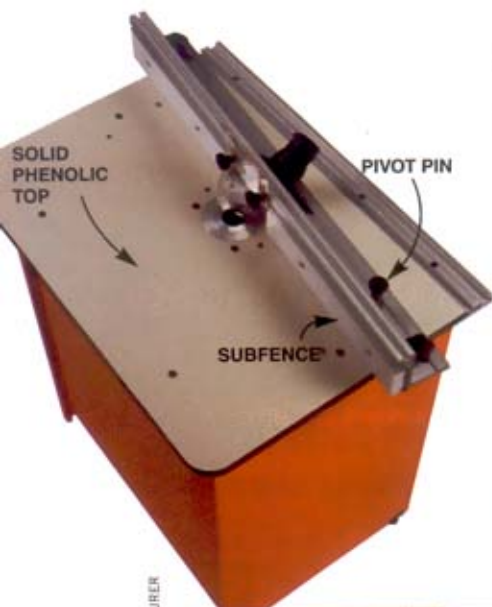
The DW980 offers a new DeWalt-made motor that produces 350 in.-lbs. of torque. It's coupled with an all-metal, transmission with *three* speeds (0 to 450 rpm, 0 to 1,400 rpm and 0 to 1,800 rpm). At low speed (0 to 450 rpm), the DW980's increased torque reminds me of my corded drill. DeWalt's industry-first third speed kicks out as much torque at 1,800 rpm as current models do at 1,400 rpm. The bottom line: More torque at faster speeds.

The Jacob's chuck on the DW980 ratchets to prevent its sleeve from coming loose during operation. It also contains a spindle lock that, according to DeWalt, allows you to clamp onto bits two times tighter than before. Result: bits don't slip, but they still pop out easily when you want to make a change.



The DW980 is probably more drill than most of us need for woodworking, but that extra oomph will sure come in handy for home improvement projects.

Shaper-Like Router Table

Notice anything different about CMT's Industrio Router top? There's no insert plate for the router. The Industrio System is designed to function like a shaper. Special wrenches make it easy to change bits from above the table, so you can mount your biggest, baddest router permanently.

The top is made of solid phenolic, an extremely rigid and stable material that, like seasoned cast iron, will stay flat far longer than melamine or MDF. The mounting hole is off-center, to take full advantage of the top's big 31 in. by 24-in. size. Aluminum inserts adjust the opening to the bit. A miter gauge track is mounted to one side.

The fence is versatile and very easy to adjust. It's made from anodized extruded aluminum and incorporates three high-density plastic subfences that adjust laterally for safe, zero-clearance routing. The outfeed side of the fence is adjustable, for jointing operations. It includes a dust collection port, slots for hold-downs, featherboards, blade guards and other accessories. End clamps quickly lock the fence anywhere on the top. In addition, the fence pivots for fine adjustments and locks securely.

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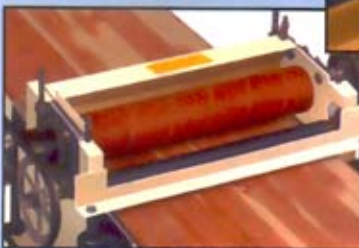

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Long Bed 6-in. Jointer

Powermatic's new PM 54A 6-in. jointer trumps the field with a 66-in.-long bed—almost a foot longer than any other 6-in. machine, and comparable in length to the beds on most 8-in. jointers. Bed length is a big deal in a jointer because it

determines the length of stock you can joint (usually 1-1/2 times the length of the bed). That means you can joint 8-ft. boards on the PM 54A, something you can't do on any other 6-in. machine.

Another innovation on the PM 54A is the dual-action adjustment lever. Traditionally, jointers employed either levers or wheels to raise and lower the infeed table. Levers are great for making quick, coarse adjustments, but wheels work better for making fine adjustments. The PM 54A allows you to make both kinds of adjustments with a lever. To make fine adjustments, you just twist the handle.

Each full rotation moves the table by only 1/16 in.

The PM 54A comes equipped with a three-knife cutterhead and a 1-hp. motor. Its 4 in. by 38-in. fence tilts left and right, with positive stops at 45 and 90 degrees. A 4-in. dust collection port is integrated into the enclosed base. Priced at \$750, the PM 54A is positioned right between other good-quality 6-in. and 8-in. jointers.

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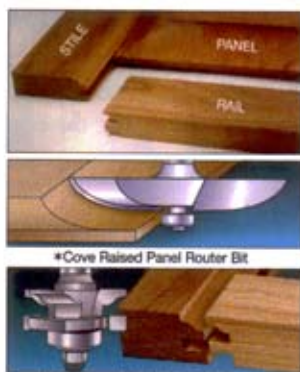

What a deal! You can save both money and shop space because the Shop Fox oscillating drill press is two machines in one.

It's big for a benchtop machine, so it has adequate capacities for most drilling operations, including 12 speeds, a 6-1/2-in. throat, 3-1/4-in. stroke, 3/4-hp motor and a 12-3/8-in.-diameter table. The 5/8-in. chuck screws onto the arbor, so it stays put, but it can't grip bits smaller than 7/64 in.

In addition, a patented system makes the spindle oscillate in a 3/4-in. stroke. The table has a hole for the sanding drum with an integral dust collection port. Three sanding drums are included.

This machine performed drilling operations as well as many of the floor-model drill presses we tested last April (AW #86).



It takes less than a minute to change the W1668 from drilling to sanding. Just remove the operator's levers, install a small belt between the arbor pulley and the gear-and-cam oscillating mechanism and align the spindle with the hole in the table.

We got good sanding results, on par with the benchtop spindle sanders we tested last October (AW #82). The W1668 has plenty of power and adequate dust collection, although the hole in the table limits maximum drum size to 2 in.

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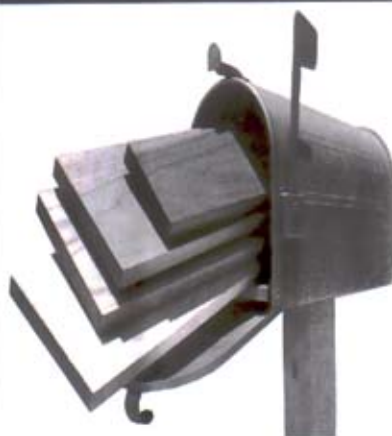

Affordable Mortising Chisel Sets Stay Sharp

If you don't want to spend a fortune on chisels and bits for your mortiser, but have been frustrated by the short life span of inexpensive sets made in China, check out this new offering from Fisch Precision Tools.

Their new Guildcraft mortising chisel sets are Chinese made, but Fisch controls the manufacturing process and imports their own high-quality steel. (Fisch is known for their top-quality professional chisel sets—they supply the Stickley Furniture Company). The result is good quality at a modest price, perfect for the home woodworker. The four-chisel set, including the tool roll (a nice perk), costs \$70.

Guildcraft chisel sets have an excellent finish grind and are a joy to use because they stay sharp. The secret is the steel. Guildcraft chisel sets are consistently hardened, so their cutting edges are uniform and less likely to break down. If you don't abuse them, these sets will last a long time, especially if you have a slow-speed (1,720 rpm) mortiser. High-speed mortisers (3,450 rpm) are hard on *all* mortising chisels. Guildcraft chisels mount with a standard 5/8-in. bushing. You may have to add the shaft extender supplied with your mortiser in order to chuck the auger bits. (Auger-bit shafts vary in length, depending on the manufacturer. These are short.)

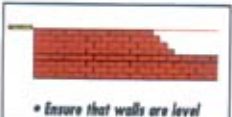
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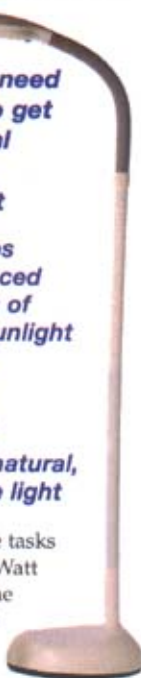
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These characteristics make birch a great choice for all types of cabinetry. But the best thing about birch is that it looks good with a variety of finishes—it's a great impostor for more expensive woods. I'll show you how to make the most of this durable, versatile and budget-friendly hardwood.

Yellow Birch Rules

Although the birch family *Betulaceae* contains over a dozen domestic species, between 80 and 90 percent of the lumber you'll find at the lumberyard is yellow birch (*Betula alleghaniensis*). Three other species are also commercially harvested and may occasionally be mixed in with yellow birch. Paper birch (*B. papyrifera*) is whiter, but softer. Sweet birch (*B. lenta*) is a bit harder and has a deeper color. River birch (*B. nigra*) is more likely to contain knots. Birch boards average about 6-in. wide, and are available in lengths up to 12 ft. Lumberyards usually stock birch in 1- and 2-in. thicknesses. Home centers carry birch plywood, but may not stock birch lumber.

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The Way Wood Works

Birch Lumber is Graded for Color

Birch logs contain quite a bit of sapwood. It ranges in color from creamy-white to golden tan (with occasional pink tones), and is distinctly different than the reddish-brown heartwood (photo, at left). Commercial demand for light-colored wood is so strong that birch, like maple, is often graded and sold by its color. You'll pay about a 20-percent premium for color-selected birch.

At the lumberyard, birch boards marketed as "sap" or "white" have been color-selected. Sap birch refers to boards containing at least 85 percent light-colored sapwood. White birch refers to paper birch. Some lumberyards carry it separately

from yellow birch, specifically for its white color. Paper birch boards are usually narrow (about 4-in. wide), short (6- to 8-ft. long) and thin (1-in. thick). They're best used to make face-frames and moldings.

Most birch lumber is sold as natural or unselected. There's no difference in the quality of the wood—it just hasn't been sorted for color. Most natural boards contain a combination of sapwood and heartwood, but you'll find light- and dark-colored boards as part of the mix. While light-colored birch grabs all the attention, its deeper-toned heartwood (red birch) can be just as attractive. Thick stock (over 1 in.) is likely to contain considerable heartwood. Lower-grade No. 1 common birch lumber contains more knots and other natural defects.

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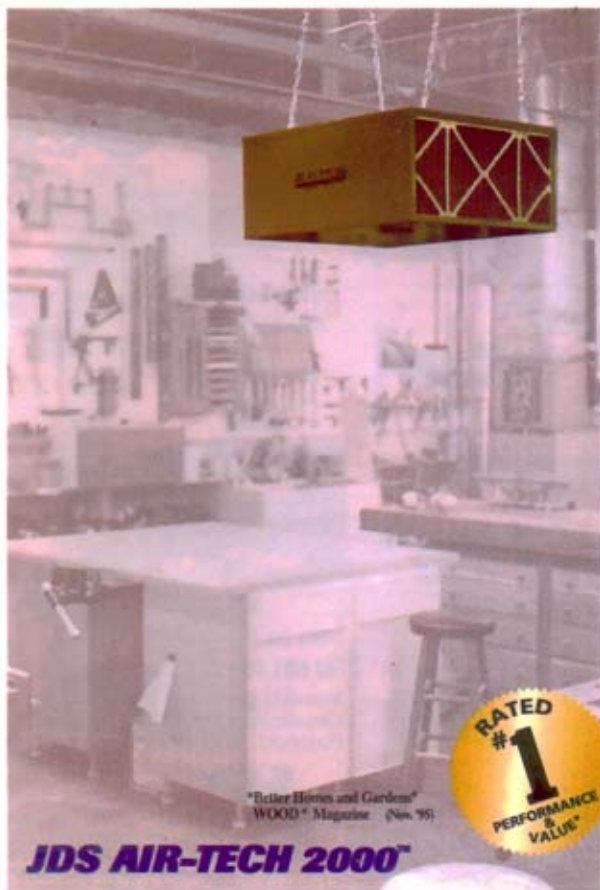


MAHOGANY



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BIRCH IS A GREAT IMPOSTOR because its figure patterns closely resemble those in cherry, mahogany and walnut. You can dress it up or down just by staining it different colors. Furniture manufacturers have used stained birch in lieu of more expensive hardwoods for decades.



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The Way Wood Works

Birch Plywood Has Many Faces

Birch plywood is graded by its color, just like birch lumber. The highest grade is white, followed by uniform light and natural. Lower paint and shop grades cost less. Hardwood lumberyards usually stock most grades.

The faces of white birch ply (here white refers to color, rather than species) are made of top-grade (zero defects), color-matched sapwood veneers. This architectural-quality plywood has a handsome appearance, but it's expensive; around \$75 per sheet.

Uniform light and natural birch ply have top-grade veneer faces, in terms of natural defects, but they're not pristinely white in color. In the past, these grades were distinctly different. Today, they're virtually identical in appearance (they're both light colored) and in price; about ten percent less than white ply. Paint and shop grades of birch plywood are worth looking at if you want to save money. They cost about \$50 per sheet. Paint-grade birch ply has face veneers that vary in color and pattern match. Shop-grade sheets have some kind of damage or manufacturing defect, but must be 85 percent usable.

TOP GRADES of birch plywood are white and uniform. They're the best choice if you want a clean, pristine look.



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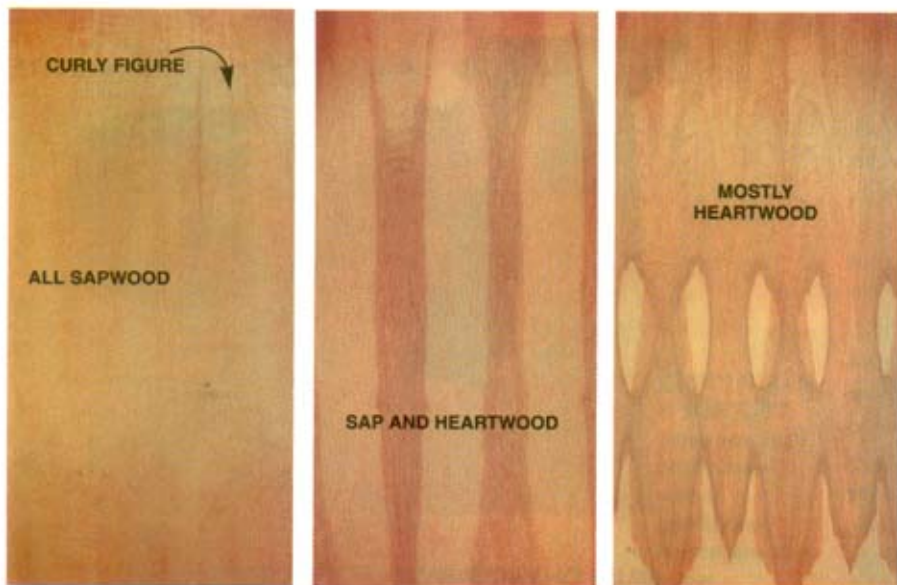
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MIDDLE-GRADE birch plywood sold at home centers offers lots of creative possibilities. The veneers may show attractive figure patterns, occasional spectacular curly figure, rich colors, and any combination of sap- and heartwood, including all of one or the other. Staining will minimize contrasting colors, but the only way to make these sheets white is to paint them!

It's smart to shop for birch plywood at a home center. They typically stock a mid-level grade, similar to the paint grade at the hardwood lumberyard, but at home center prices. This plywood will vary widely in appearance from sheet to sheet, and will contain minor natural defects, varying amounts of heartwood and slightly less uniform core material, but you'll save up to 50 percent, compared to the top white grades at the hardwood lumberyard. You'll also be able to look through the stack for the best-looking sheets. Take a friend along to help you look, be careful, and leave the stack neat for the next customer.

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The Way Wood Works

Seal Birch Before You Stain

Curly figure is common in birch and occasionally it's spectacular. Flame birch can look as cool as tiger maple. Usually, though, figure is a big nuisance because it's randomly located and hard to see. If you're not careful, a piece with hidden curly figure can end up in the wrong place on your project. One curly board in a tabletop will stick out like a sore thumb, especially if you use stain. It's a good idea to check every board for figure. Just wipe on some mineral spirits; any figure will jump right out. If you're stuck with curly figure in the wrong place, using wood conditioner before you stain helps camouflage it.



BRUSH ON WATER-BASED WOOD CONDITIONER, let it dry and sand lightly before you stain. This process helps the wood absorb water-based stain evenly. Each coat of stain adds a little more color. You can tweak the color by using different colored stains, one over another. Water-based stains dry fast, so you can put on several coats in a day.

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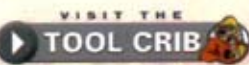
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STAIN ON RAW BIRCH

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The Way Wood Works

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Birch's chameleon-like nature makes it a finisher's dream wood. It looks good with a clear finish, accepts all colors of stains and dyes, and has a smooth surface that's great for painting.



KEEP IT LIGHT. Waterborne polyurethane adds no amber color, so it keeps birch as light as possible. Lacquer finishes are also clear. Oil-based finishes add an amber tone.



IMITATE EXPENSIVE HARDWOODS like mahogany, walnut or cherry. To simulate the open-pored appearance of mahogany or walnut, use a single coat of water-based conditioner before staining. You'll get an evenly colored finish and some stain will darken the pores, just like the real McCoy. To imitate close-pored woods like cherry, use two coats of conditioner. When you stain, the pores won't show up at all.



MATCH OLD BIRCH cabinets or trim moldings that have aged to a uniform honey color by sealing new birch with two coats of water-based conditioner, just as if you were matching a close-pored wood. Then add color, using a golden-oak colored water-based stain.



PAINT IT. Because of its uniform texture and tiny pores, birch provides a smooth surface for painting. It's tougher than pine or poplar, and unselected grades cost about the same. For cabinetry, even the ugliest birch plywood will look great when it's painted.

Birch or Hard Maple?

Yellow birch and hard maple look so much alike it's often tough to tell them apart. Plainsawn boards have similar figure patterns. They both have pale sapwood and distinctly darker heartwood. Manufacturers have used them interchangeably for decades.

How do they compare?

- Hard-maple sapwood is whiter.
- Hard maple will make a better cutting block or countertop, but yellow birch is tough enough to stand up to normal dings and dents.
- Both show considerable seasonal movement.
- Both yellow with age.
- Birch machines better. Hard maple is particularly prone to tear-out during edge jointing, and burn marks from dull blades and bits are tougher to remove.
- Birch accepts stain better, although both are prone to blotching.
- Birch costs less. Although demand for light-colored wood continues to push up the price of both species, birch is usually about 30-percent cheaper. **AW**

Curly Koa

Two things make curly koa precious; it is strikingly beautiful and very rare. Koa only grows at the higher elevations of the Hawaiian Islands and less than 3 percent of all koa is figured. Curly koa is truly the rarest of the rare.

Crowned the king of the Hawaiian forest, *Acacia koa* is a true American tropical exotic (another rarity) that can reach a height of 100 ft. with a 5- to 10-ft.-diameter trunk. A scarce natural resource like koa demands protection and fortunately it gets it. Controlled cutting and an aggressive reforestation program are designed to guarantee an ongoing supply of koa to craftsman for generations to come.

Koa is comparable to walnut in hardness. It is stable, works well (although curly koa can be a little tricky to surface), and takes an exceptionally rich finish with oil or varnish.

We found our curly koa at Eisenbrand Hardwoods. Eisenbrand carries koa and curly koa in thicknesses ranging from 3/8 in. to 2 in. and in widths up to 12 in. Prices vary depending on figure, width and thickness of stock from \$12 per bd. ft. to \$49 per bd. ft. All of their koa is air dried to minimize drying defects. Air-dried wood is generally too wet to use right out of the box. Eisenbrand provides a tip sheet on how to bring the moisture content of your wood down to acceptable levels. (See also, Q&A, AW #87, June 2001, page 8.) **AW**

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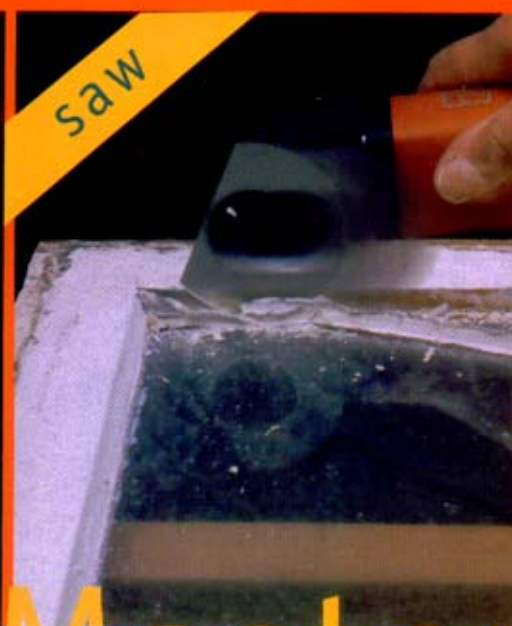
